Para 1.17 and 1.19	Our fundraising involves a monthly teddy/ball draw, weekly Facebook Auctions, Raffles, Sales of Merchandise via Facebook and our Website, Donations and Events. We also receive funds via Easy Fundraising, One Lottery, Just Giving, Wonderful.org, Paypal Giving, Sponsored Events from our supporters and recycling schemes. We have also been successful in applying and receiving Grants from Pets at Home and the Animal Foundation. Our supporters and followers help to promote UK Boston Terrier Rescue and our aims of raising awareness of the breed and the proper care of Boston Terriers. Each surrender form submitted is reviewed and discussed by the Trustees of UKBTR (currently 8 Trustees) to ensure we can safely receive them into Foster Homes.

		56 dogs have been surrendered during the accounting period, 40 being adopted, 9 being permanent (Primrose) foster dogs, 6 in current foster and 1 awaiting a foster place

As the charity trustees of the Charity you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').




