

# ANNUAL MINISTRY REPORT

## International Bible Teacher (IBT)

2025

**Our mission:** Teach All Nations - Europe is called to fulfil the 'great commission of Jesus Christ' by advancing His glorious gospel worldwide. It starts with evangelism, continues with discipleship and teaching (Matthew 28:18-20), and culminates in 'bearing much spiritual fruit' to the honour and glory of God (John 15:1-8).

**Our tagline:** *Empowering through Word and Spirit.* When the Word and Spirit line up, your chances of getting it right are one hundred per cent. When either the Word, or Spirit, or both are missing, your chances of getting it wrong are ... one hundred per cent. The goal is a spiritual revival, reformation, restoration and renewal - the only solutions to saving souls and our Western (Christian) civilisation.

**Our primary emphasis:** The Bible - the Holy Scriptures — the Word of God (Proverbs 30:5; Isaiah 40:8; Matthew 4:4; 2 Timothy 3:16) and the power of the Holy Spirit (John 14:26; Acts 1:8; 1 Corinthians 12, 14; Ephesians 5:18; 6:10,18; Jude 20).

### Activities of Teach All Nations - Europe

1. **Atypical Year:** This has been the most unusual year for TAN-E. Especially in the lack of overseas travel. With our emphasis on TAN Digital and reformatting ministry in an ever-changing world. The need for God's Word, especially among Generation Z in the much-observed Quiet Revival, is greater than ever. But the mode of delivery must change, and that is a major part of our activities in 2025.
2. **TAN Digital:** The goal is to host all TAN teaching resources: audio, video, books and articles in one place and accessible to the seven billion smartphones in the world. This is a massive project and took up much of the year. Ultimately, the goal, as crafted in our TAN-E trustees retreat, is the *"Whole Word for the Whole World by the Holy Spirit."*
3. **Public Ministry:** I am still preaching, especially at Banbury Community Church, where I serve on the preaching roster. Occasionally, I give a public message based on the Middle East and Bible prophecy. On 29 September, I gave my first ever public meeting in Banbury, where I have been based for the past eight years. The message was about Jerusalem, the Burdensome Stone (Zechariah 12). The local Anglican church was represented, along with the Evangelical Free and Banbury Community Church. I got a lot of comments about the amount of content (I have been dealing with this content for decades). It was a good night. Another ministry highlight was being the

main speaker at the Congolese Christian Conference in London, exactly twenty years after my actual ministry trip in Congo. It was great to be 'back in Africa' again.

4. **Current projects:** In addition to developing TAN DIGITAL Plus APP, I am finishing the second draft of my new book: *Behold, I Come Quickly: Understanding the Book of Revelation.* I am also on my third edition of *Rivers of Living Water: The Holy Spirit Today.*
5. **The Future:** This is the million, trillion-dollar topic. Bible prophecy gives us a heads-up on the subject. I speak on the subject often. What I have said for years, and speak emphatically today, it's this: if ever there was a time to trust God, it is now. If ever there was a time to walk with God, it's today. And if you want a guaranteed brighter future, it is to travel the path of the just (Proverbs 4:18). Heaven eagerly awaits our response.

## **ANNUAL MINISTRY REPORT** **International Bible Teacher (IBT)**

**2024**

**Our mission:** Teach All Nations - Europe is called to fulfil the 'great commission of Jesus Christ' by advancing His glorious gospel worldwide. It starts with evangelism, continues with discipleship and teaching (Matthew 28:18-20), and culminates in 'bearing much spiritual fruit' to the honour and glory of God (John 15:1-8).

**Our tagline:** *Empowering through Word and Spirit.* When the Word and Spirit line up, your chances of getting it right are one hundred per cent. When either the Word, or Spirit, or both are missing, your chances of getting it wrong are ... one-hundred per cent. The goal is a spiritual revival, reformation, restoration and renewal - the only solutions to saving souls and our Western (Christian) civilisation.

**Our primary emphasis:** The Bible - the Holy Scriptures — the Word of God (Proverbs 30:5; Isaiah 40:8; Matthew 4:4; 2 Timothy 3:16) and the power of the Holy Spirit (John 14:26; Acts 1:8; 1 Corinthians 12, 14; Ephesians 5:18; 6:10,18; Jude 20).

### **Activities of Teach All Nations - Europe**

The activities of TAN-E are primarily conducted through our International Bible Teacher Rev. Kameel Majdali, PhD (Melb) and his wife Leanne. TAN-E seeks to advance our goals through prayer, public meetings, online ministry, hosting Bible-based holy land tours, and producing teaching materials such as audio MP3s, video MP4s, and books.

Activities during **2024** included the following:

1. **Travel Ministry:** Travel in ministry has been less than pre-COVID levels, but we had some wonderful ministry in Europe and Australia during this season. This year saw an open door at Herrnhut, Saxony in (eastern Germany). Herrnhut is famous as the headquarters of the Moravian movement, known for their prayer (chain) that lasted one hundred years and their missionary emphasis. The TAN-E IBT preached to a healthy crowd on Sunday and did a UTT-style meeting on Monday. Despite the short notice, fifty people came from near and far to learn about the war in the Middle East and its five dimensions. He also had his first time speaking in the Czech capital at Heart Prague

Church and its international congregation. It, too, was a UTT/YEWS meeting involving the Middle East war. Also, two UTT meetings were held in the UK: Exeter, Devon and Redruth, Cornwall. Finally, there has been regular, often monthly, preaching at the local Banbury Community Church. During the year, there was 'Zoom Ministry,' where he spoke to people via the Internet. It expanded our reach, though we prefer in-person meetings where possible. In addition to UTT-style ministry, we did our annual visit to the churches in South Moravia in the Czech Republic. As always, they wanted ministry involving the Holy Spirit, current events and Bible prophecy. South Moravia has been our most consistent and fruitful place of ministry in Europe thus far, followed by Romania.

2. **Introducing Your Early Warning Service (YEWS):** Since 2007, YEWS is a current event, Bible prophecy presentation that often focuses on the Middle East. YEWS has been hosted by local churches in all Australian states, the Northern Territory, and around the world. As mentioned, TAN-E held its first YEWS meetings in Redruth and Exeter in 2024. We desire to have more as the ministerial doors open.
3. **Resource production - Bible study:** Many of the programs recorded for Australian Christian radio became part of our TAN Store as the 'Understanding the Bible' Series, a verse-by-verse audio commentary (plus printable PDF notes) as a digital download. In order to complete the entire New Testament in this format, the following Bible books have yet to be recorded and produced: **2 Peter, 1 John, 2 John, 3 John, and Jude** (eleven chapters in total). These 'postcard epistles' will be attended to in the not-too-distant future. The research, writing of notes, and recording of a twenty-minute program, which the IBT has been doing since 2004, is time-intensive. Wisdom decrees that he have a break so he can focus on other projects.

## **Resources Produced in 2024**

**The following are new resources:**

1. **MP3** *Practical Wisdom Today and Faith That Works: Understanding the Book of James* (22 hours).
2. **MP3** *Triumph Over All: Understanding the Book of 1 Peter* (19 hours).
3. **BOOK** *Welcome Holy Spirit- Understanding the Book of Acts* (300-page book).
4. **Prayer:** Prayer includes daily personal prayer, online weekly with a prayer group called 'Prayer for the Nations,' (led by our treasurer Richard Bush) and recently (July 2024) on-site in five European countries (Poland, Lithuania, Latvia, Estonia, and Finland. There is also prayer input at the local church where the Majdalis attend.
5. **Christian magazines:** The IBT continues to regularly contribute articles to Christian periodicals, like *Sword Magazine* (UK) and *Christians for Israel's Newspaper* (The Netherlands); the latter pays for the articles.

6. **Online ministry:** We continue to offer the podcast Beyond the Box, which is about current events in the light of God's Word. TAN continues to offer a YouTube Channel called '*Global Pulpit: The Unchanging Word for Changing Times.*' Sermons are regularly posted there, including those recorded in host churches, posting will be less frequent during this downtime since Global Pulpit is more time-intensive than Beyond the Box
7. **Issachar Teaching eLetter:** A monthly teaching eLetter that goes to several thousand subscribers worldwide, mostly in Australia, but also includes the UK, USA, SE Asia (Singapore and Malaysia) and Europe. The goal is to help people become 'future-ready' with articles from the Bible, victorious Christian living, and current events in the light of God's Word. We have been regularly sending Issachar since 2015, though it was sent periodically for several years earlier.
8. **Deep Dive 2024: Behold I Come Quickly: Understanding the Second Coming of Christ**  
We held our third annual Deep Dive online class as a follow-up to the Australian YEWS Tour of 2024. It is for those who want to learn more than what is available in a seventy-five-minute public YEWS presentation. **TAN-Europe hosted Deep Dive.** Around thirty-five people registered for the four sessions in November 2024. This figure is lower than in previous years, but part of the explanation was a shorter YEWS tour limited only to Victoria. While student satisfaction was positive, we need wisdom on attracting repeat participants and extending our reach beyond those who first attended a YEWS meeting before signing up for Deep Dive.

Despite the challenging times, we look forward to revival, reformation, restoration, renewal and, most wonderfully, the rapture, where we shall ever be with the Lord.

# International Bible Teacher's ANNUAL REPORT

2022-2023

**Our mission:** Teach All Nations-Europe (TAN-E) is to fulfil the 'great commission of Jesus Christ' by advancing His glorious gospel. It starts with evangelism, continues with discipleship and teaching (Matthew 28:18-20), and culminates in 'bearing spiritual fruit' to the honour and glory of God (John 15:1-8).

**Our tagline:** *Empowering through Word and Spirit.* The goal is a spiritual revival, reformation, restoration and renewal - the only solutions to saving souls and our civilisation.

**Our primary emphasis:** The Bible - the Holy Scriptures — the Word of God (Proverbs 30:5; Isaiah 40:8; Matthew 4:4; 2 Timothy 3:16) and the power of the Holy Spirit (John 14:26; Acts 1:8; 1 Corinthians 12, 14; Ephesians 5:18, 6:10,18; Jude 20).

## Activities of Teach All Nations - Europe

The activities of TAN-E are primarily conducted through our International Bible Teacher, Rev. Kameel Majdali, PhD (Melb). TAN-E seeks to advance our goals through prayer, public meetings, online and radio broadcasting, hosting Bible-based holy land tours, and producing teaching materials such as audio MP3s, video MP4s, and books.

Activities during **2022-2023** included the following:

1. **Travel Ministry:** Travel in the post-Covid period has been slow in picking up but, nevertheless, there were trips to Israel, the United States, and two trips into continental Europe. **Czech Republic:** Though Rev. Majdali has been ministering here on an annual basis since 2015 (except for Covid), there was a major breakthrough in May 2023. Until then, his ministry was limited to South Moravia but on this last trip, he was a guest speaker at a nationwide pastor's conference, thus meeting and ministering to pastors from all over the republic. In addition, a door opened in Herrnhut, Germany on the same trip and there is the possibility of return (this small town was famous as the epicentre of the Moravian revival).
2. **Understanding the Times 2022 (UTT):** This service commenced in Melbourne in 2007 and seeks to present key current events in the light of God's Word, especially Bible prophecy. Since 2015 TAN/UTT obtained a media partner through Vision Christian

Radio, which opened doors across Australia, geographically and trans-denominationally. After a three-year Covid-generated absence, the Majdalis completed the eighth (2022) and the ninth (2023) annual Australia-Wide Understanding the Times Tour. There were forty meetings in 2022 and thirty-three meetings in 2023. During the upcoming 2023-2024 year we will diligently seek to replicate a smaller version of UTT in the United Kingdom and possibly Europe. **(NOTE: A ninth annual UTT Tour occurred in September-October 2023).**

- 3. Resource production - Bible study:** Books were written and audiobooks recorded. In addition, is the *Understanding the Bible Series*, consisting of verse-by-verse audio MP3 commentaries on key Bible books. We have around thirty Bible books with verse-by-verse commentary, including most of the New Testament (it is anticipated that the remainder of the New Testament - James; 1 & 2 Peter; 1, 2, 3 John & Jude will be completed in 2024). In addition to the audio programs, these teachings include printable PDF notes. A list of new resources produced in 2022-23 is at the end of this report.
- 4. Prayer:** Prayer includes daily personal prayer, online weekly with a British prayer group called 'Prayer for the Nations,' and prayer retreats in various locations in the UK, plus recently (June 2023) on-site in ten European countries. There is also prayer input at the local church where the Majdalis attend.

Doors are opening in the UK, including the 're-digging the wells of revival' prayer initiative that began here in 2023. A pre-coronation prayer intensive was held at the British Parliament building, outside Buckingham Palace, and inside Westminster Abbey. Out of that experience Rev. Majdali, has a new sermon called '*The Coronation and the Anointing of the Holy Spirit,*' which has been well-received in the UK and Czech Republic.

- 5. Christian magazines:** Rev. Majdali continues to contribute articles to Christian periodicals, like *Sword Magazine*, *Christians for Israel's newspaper*, and, on occasion, *Premier Christian Radio's Online Magazine 'Christianity.'*
- 6. Online ministry:** TAN-E developed an online YouTube Channel called '*Global Pulpit: The Unchanging Word for Changing Times.*' Sermons are regularly posted there, including those recorded in host churches. In addition, we have a podcast called '*Beyond the Box*' with current events in the light of God's Word.
- 7. Issachar Teaching eLetter:** A monthly teaching eLetter that goes to several thousand subscribers worldwide, including the UK, Australia, the USA and Europe. The goal is to help people become 'future-ready' with articles from the Bible, victorious Christian living, and current events in the light of God's Word. We have been regularly sending Issachar since 2015.
- 8. Deep Dive 2022: World Trends and Bible Prophecy.** We held our first annual Deep Dive online class as a follow-up to the Understanding the Times Tour. It is for those who want to learn more than what is available in a seventy-five-minute public presentation.

Deep Dive was hosted by Teach All Nations-Europe. Around one hundred people registered for the four sessions in November-December 2022, including the UK and Europe. Further 'Deep Dives' will be planned for the future. **(NOTE: A second Deep Dive called *The Book of Revelation: What You Should Know*, hosted October 2023).**

9. **Current Projects:** *What We Believe* is a teaching series of basic Christian doctrine and a Biblical perspective on key contemporary issues. Also *Israel @ War: Prophecy Fulfilled? Series* discussing current events in the Middle East and if and how they might be a fulfilment of end-time prophecy.



In the Spring of 2022, the IBT was able to make two trips to Europe, the first since the start of the Covid-19 pandemic and lockdowns.







### ACTIVITIES

Our activities, primarily conducted through our International Bible Teacher (IBT), seek to advance our goals through prayer, public meetings, broadcast both online and on radio, hosting Bible-based holy land tours, and the production of teaching materials as DVDs, Audio MP3s, and books.

Due to Covid-19 restrictions the IBT did not travel outside the United Kingdom nor conduct public meetings inside the United Kingdom. Everything was done online.


Activities during **2020-2021** included the following:

5. **Youtube Channel:** Developed an online Channel called '*Global Pulpit: The Unchanging Word for Changing Times.*' This is our weekly sermon.
6. **Issachar Teaching eLetter:** Distribution of a monthly teaching eLetter called 'Issachar' which goes to several thousand subscribers worldwide.
7. **'Understanding the Times' Annual Presentation:** This is looking a current events in the light of God's Word. Normally done as a public speaking tour in conjunction Christian radio, the 2020 event moved online with the the topic: *Beyond Covid-19, Recession and Riots: Is There A Word from the Lord?*
