## Chairmans Report October 2024-October 2025

Once again we are very pleased to report that Memorial Hall continues to be the living ,breathing heart of the Old Malton Community. There has been a two new housing development in the village and this increases our “customer base” .These new people are using the hall and attending the many and varied activities going on there. The structure of the hall continues to be improved and all external window and doors have been painted. The internal walls and decoration still need attention. We continue to fund raise towards this work although estimates of 30-40 thousand pounds are beyond our means at the moment so we have applied for local grants. A recent completion of a Care home in the village has meant the company was able to provide us with some funding. The Solar panels continue to help with our electricity costs.

The Annual “Peakerfest” is a continued success and raised over £600 from one evening. Monthly Bingo’s and domino drives are combined with Children’s parties, Dog training , Brass band practices . We continue to be the social base for Ryedale Special families. Mother and baby classes, Elections, A.A meetings, Am Dram performances, along with Yoga and Pilates classes all make for an extremely busy venue.

### Trustees/ Chairmans Report October 2022

After the two year shut down the hall has emerged once more as the centre of the Old Malton Community. The village has increased in size with a new estate of 40 houses and this has been reflected by our new extended committee, two of which live in the new houses. We now have 7 people on the committee and can begin to share the load of job responsibilities. The toilet re-vamp has now been enhanced by kitchen improvements and the back section of the hall is much tidier. We are still looking to improve the main hall ceiling and floor with a new stage area with lighting and an in-house PA system. Funding for this has already been agreed with a local business. We now have a de-fibrillator on the hall entrance and training for the people of the village is being arranged soon. We also plan to provide broadband for hall users. We have a paid gardener who visits every other week but his work has been minimised due to the help of the "Community Service "people who, under supervision have cleared all the hedging to the rear of the property and made improvements to the car park surface.

The hall is now in daily use by several Fitness groups, Ryedale special families, Men-cap, Latin line dancing, Pilates, Charity Brass band , Dog training, Bee keepers, and even a group of Naturists, (behind closed doors obviously).

THE hall has been included in a Ryedale Solar panel scheme and surveys are underway to establish feasibility . THE committee have attended several meetings with Jos Holmes who is the NYCC Climate Change Policy Officer.

The hall continues with its own fundraising efforts with a Talent Night planned for October along with a children's Halloween Party later in the month.

The committee report, at last to being even more proud of the hall and we hope that the recent improvements will increase hall usage..

### Trustees/ Chairmans Report October 2021

The hall has undergone a difficult year with several of the committee resigning due to work commitments and the pandemic but we emerge into another year as “Hall custodians” with renewed enthusiasm with several new committee members who have new ideas and drive.

As reported we have completed the work on the toilets and can now provide a re-vamped multi-sex toilet as well as separate disabled unit. Along with a new disabled ramp we feel that the hall is now much more accessible for all. The above work was completed with funding help from Malton Town council and grants obtained during closure.

We have approached a building company, Duchy Homes who are building a new estate in the village and they have agreed to provide us with a new kitchen. This has been installed and completion is expected shortly. We now have a modernised section of the hall which makes it much more attractive for potential hire. We hope to move on shortly to the ceiling and floor in the main hall which is in need of renovation. The committee report, at last to being proud of the hall and we hope that the return to normality will bring along extra usage.

We recently held a musical evening to celebrate the hall re-opening and over £500 was raised towards the ceiling project. We have been host to a travelling theatre group and also held a Halloween party with over 95 kids there all in fancy dress. The use of the hall for children’s parties shows real potential.

We now have proper part –time cleaner and gardener helping to keep the place looking tidy.

The hall continues to be used by a variety of groups including over 60’s keep –fit , pilates, Zumba, Ryedale special families, Village Bingo, etc ,etc.
