THE ADVANCEMENT OF EDUCATION, PARTICULARLY BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY AT CHARLESWORTH SCHOOL, LONG LANE AND TOWN LANE, CHARLESWORTH, GLOSSOP, SK13 5ET BY WAY OF THE PROVISION OF BUILDINGS FOR THE SCHOOL, OF THE APPOINTMENT OF A FOUNDATION GOVERNOR ON THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS AND THE REGULAR LEADING OF ASSEMBLIES AT THE SCHOOL. 3. THE PREVENTION OR RELIEF OF SUFFERING, POVERTY AND DISTRESS, PARTICULARLY, BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY, BY WAY OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO CHRISTIAN CHARITIES, LOCAL, NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL, WHOSE OBJECTS INCLUDE THE SUPPORT OF PERSONS FACING PERSECUTION FOR THEIR FAITH, RACE, ETHNIC ORIGIN AND THOSE SUFFERING THE EFFECTS OF WAR, STRIFE AND NATURAL DISASTER 4. SUCH OTHER PURPOSES AS ARE EXCLUSIVELY CHARITABLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAWS OF ENGLAND AND WALES AS THE TRUSTEES MAY FROM TIME TO TIME DECIDE.
