Overview

The new small room and bar have continued to be a useful facility and has proved to be an asset to the village hall. The hall is still used by several organisations and private hires, and it continues to be a valuable centre for the village's social life.

Activities

The Caston Women's Institute, Yoga Club and Art Club continue to be regular hirers of the hall together with the dance group. During the winter months we were again able to hold Saturday morning breakfasts on the first Saturdays of the month and hope to continue this facility later with the onset of winter months. Quizzes and Whist Drives arranged by Lynsey and Philip Doughty are regularly supported. The hall continues to be hired for private parties and special occasions such as wakes, baby showers receptions and the like. Caston PCC hired the hall for a Race Night.

Friday "Drop In" coffee mornings coordinated by Kay Farmbrough continue to be well supported and are a great social occasion.

Building and Structural Work

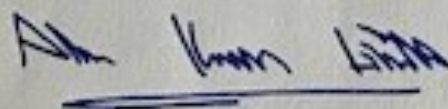
The monthly safety checks are carried out by the Booking Secretary and Deputy Chairman and any defects rectified. Following an unfortunate accident to a child's finger, guards have been fitted to the door jambs between the kitchen and main hall and the door between the foyer and main hall. Wear damage to the stage front has been repaired. Additional PIR sensors have been fitted to illuminate the side path. No major structural work has been done this year, but the committee are considering possible future projects such as solar panels and improvement to the underfloor insulation to the main hall.
