The charity was entered on the Register of Charities on 15th December 2015. Its Charity number is 1164870.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The charity is governed by a constitution dated 15th December 2015, and is constituted as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation.

Trustees are appointed by a resolution passed at a properly convened meeting of the charity trustees, and must be appointed for a term of three years.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The objectives of the charity are to advance the Christian religion by supporting the Christian mission of the Church of England Church of St Peter and St Paul in West Clandon, Surrey, including (without limitation) (1) by preserving, keeping up, heating, lighting, insuring, maintaining, enhancing or extending the fabric (including fixtures and contents) of that Church, its churchyard and burial ground, and (2) by supporting the pastoral work of that Church towards the young, the bereaved, the elderly, the sick and other groups in need. No fundraising events took place during the year. However in due course it is expected that the charity will resume its usual fundraising activities. It is the belief of the trustees that this will provide an adequate means of ensuring that funds are used for their intended purpose and for the public benefit.

During the year the charity made donations of £5,000 from unrestricted funds towards the costs of roofing and stonework repairs and £550 towards the cost of a new website.

Expenditure from restricted funds comprised donations to the church in respect of repairs to stonework and the roof.

NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED

31ST DECEMBER 2022

- 1 The principal accounting policies are set out below:
 - a) **Basis of preparation**

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland ("FRS2") including Section 1A, and with the Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with FRS102 issued in 2014 and revised in 2016. The accounts are also prepared in accordance with the Charities Act 2011.
 - b) **Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds are those which are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charity and which have not been designated for other purposes. Restricted funds are those designated for specific purposes.
 - c) **Going concern**

The trustees are confident that the charity will continue to be going concern, and the accounts have been prepared on this basis.
 - d) **Income and expenditure**

Income is accounted for in the year in which it is received, and expenditure is accounted for in the year in which it is incurred.
- 2 **Legal status of the charity**

The charity is governed by a constitution dated 15th December 2015, and is incorporated as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation.
- 3 **Trustees' remuneration**

The trustees received no remuneration for the period.
