### **Report of the Trustees For The Year Ended 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024**

#### **Objectives and Aims**

The aim of the RCYC Sailing Trust is to advance young people in life through the provision of facilities and instruction for sailing so as to develop their capabilities that they may grow to full maturity as individuals and members of society.

We particularly intend to facilitate access to an experience on the water for those either by lack of means or a limiting physical or mental capacity, who are unlikely in any way to gain an experience at sea in some appropriate manner, and at least that they should have an opportunity to enjoy the experience once in their lives of the significant maritime heritage and amenity that surrounds the county they live in.

We are aware that many school children and those who may rely on a carer, or indeed be a carer at a vulnerable and formative age for a parent while growing up in Cornwall, may never properly experience the seas around them.

We sincerely hope that some may even be inspired to reconsider their own future hopes and opportunities which may involve a maritime aspect either by way of formal training, sailing or even a future career.

Sir Ben Ainslie KBE, as well as being a member of the Royal Cornwall Yacht Club, is our Patron and supports the objectives of the RCYC Sailing Trust in the County he learned to sail race and love the sea as a child.

## **Achievement and Performance**

The Trust has been involved this year in providing life enhancing experiences for almost a hundred local disadvantaged children and their carers. Events included a 'pirate themed day' at sea where 80 youngsters were able to view the start of the exclusive Richard Mille Cup Race in the waters of Falmouth Bay watching the most beautiful classic super yachts and their crews compete for the Richard Mille Cup. As well as two sailing events aboard the Helen Mary, a Bowman 57 sail training vessel, operated by the Morvagh Sailing Project which is youth development organisation with the aim of helping young people become more confident, more resilient, more motivated and better able to communicate.

“It was a lot of fun because you got to pilot the boat and help set up the sails”.

“It was a great opportunity for the students to get out into the community and with their peers where they took part in an activity that some had never experienced before. This is so beneficial in preparing our students for adulthood”

The Trust has worked with a number of support groups schools and other trusts giving support for children. Our true outcomes are measured in the minds words and feedback of the children and carers attending our events. We are grateful for their involvement with the RCYC Sailing Trust.

Up to a hundred children joining us on board the Princessa Ferry to watch the start of the racing and be greeted by the racing yacht crews. This event was featured on both the main local news TV channels BBC Spotlight and ITV Westcountry. Feedback from the children was a major satisfaction for the helpers and volunteers and the children were also interviewed by the TV crews. **ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE**

**Charitable activities**

In 2023 we will be resuming our activities post COVID limitations. Given the vulnerabilities of some of our beneficiaries, both we and the schools we collaborate with wished to avoid bringing together children and their carers into an inevitable close environment aboard a seagoing vessel. Unfortunately, this limitation continued into 2022.

In 2023 our planned activities include taking a group of children out on the water to witness the start of the Azores And Back race (AZAB) in June, followed by an event based around the famous Tall Ships Races Magellan-Elcano 2023 in August and visit to the Pendennis Superyacht refit restoration and bespoke yard in Falmouth.

During the year the Trust took the decision to sell our boat a SB20 "Flippet" as we can use the funds more effectively for the maximum benefit of those we aim to serve rather than retain it solely for racing due to assessed impracticalities.

During the year the Trust gratefully received donations totalling £537 (2020: £120).

**FINANCIAL REVIEW**

**Financial position**

At the end of the year the Charity held unrestricted reserves of £7,183 (2020: £5,348).

### NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2021

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

##### **Basis of preparing the financial statements**

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

##### **Income**

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

##### **Expenditure**

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

##### **Tangible fixed assets**

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Boats - 20% on reducing balance

##### **Taxation**

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

##### **Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

##### **Hire purchase and leasing commitments**

Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to the Statement of Financial Activities on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

### **REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES** **FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2020**

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2020. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

##### **Objectives and aims**

The aim of the RCYC Sailing Trust is to advance young people in life through the provision of facilities and instruction for sailing so as to develop their capabilities that they may grow to full maturity as individuals and members of society.

We are aware that many school children and those who may rely on a carer, or indeed be a carer at a vulnerable and formative age for a parent while growing up in Cornwall, may never properly experience the seas around them.

We sincerely hope that some may even be inspired to reconsider their own future hopes and opportunities which may involve a maritime aspect either by way of formal training, sailing or even a future career.

Sir Ben Ainslie, as well as being a member of the Royal Cornwall Yacht Club, is our Patron and supports the objectives of the RCYC Sailing Trust in the County he learned to sail race and love the sea as a child.

#### **ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE**

##### **Charitable activities**

During 2020/21 the Trust's activities were greatly reduced by the pandemic that swept the country.

Our planned events had to be cancelled and future events put on hold. In 2021/22 we will be resuming our activities and will also be taking children out to sea in conjunction with Junior Sailing at the RCYC.



#### **1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

##### **Basis of preparing the financial statements**

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

##### **Income**

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

##### **Expenditure**

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

##### **Tangible fixed assets**

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Boats - 20% on reducing balance

##### **Taxation**

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

##### **Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
