1. Introduction

The Board of Trustees humbly presents this report to highlight the stewardship, outreach activities, and community impact of the church during the reporting period. Guided by our mission to serve God and humanity, the church has continued to extend its reach beyond the sanctuary by addressing spiritual, educational, social, and health-related needs within our congregation and the wider community. 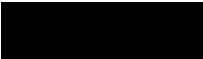

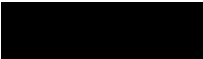
