#### **Report of the Independent Examiner to the trustees**

#### **on the accounts of the Charity for the year end 28 February 2021**

I report on the financial statements of the Charity on pages 6 to 9 for the year ended 28 February 2021 which have been prepared on a Receipts and Payments basis. A Receipts and Payments basis does not account for debtors, creditors, accruals and prepayments, but such a presentation is permitted by law for smaller charities.
