The church also embarks on radio broadcast on Sunday Morning 7am to 9am to encourage and pray for the community and our dear listeners. Radio broadcast is a method of evangelism to recruit people into the church and to further enlighten the public on moral awareness and how to live peacefully in the society. The church also prays for people to prevail in our country and the world at large.

Frankly speaking the leaders and pastors of the church do not receive any salaries or wages as this is a voluntary charity organisation geared to serve mankind in the community. Donations and church offerings are the source of revenue for the church. This revenue is also what the church uses to pay our rent every month, so that we can meet every Sunday and sometimes Fridays for Bible study and prayer meetings. Virtual meetings are sometimes arranged for Bible study and prayers.

Higher Kingdom Church aims at improving the lives of its people and members in the community. It is open to the public for counselling, support to people who require help and assistance and signposting individuals to resources within the community. Used clothes and other valuables are sometimes given out to the needy and people in the community.

Once a while Higher Kingdom Church organise a get together for people to have hot meals, drinks and dance to ease off stress. The church is open to the needs of the people in the community where in some instances we have donated cash to the vulnerable people such as the elderly.

The church hopes to expand its evangelistic crusade to recruit more people into the group because the harvest is plenty, but the labourers are few and we as a church need more labourers to help build the community together. The church is therefore looking forward to receiving more volunteers to assist and help others within the community.

HIGHER KINGDOM CHURCH INTERNATIONAL – ANNUAL ACCOUNTS 2022.

The financial year for 2022 has been very challenging as income realised was less than expenditure. This was partly due to low offering and donations from members of the Charity. Now the church is not raising funds or soliciting financial support from any other group apart from the offerings from members who attend the church.

The church usually meets online on Fridays and in person on Sundays. This was due to the lockdown which affected members from coming to church on Sundays. Now that, there is no more lockdowns, it the hope of the church that, members and new people will join the church for moral training, discipline, and magnanimity benevolence which may increase the number of people that come in.

Higher Kingdom Church International pays monthly rent of £400 this financial making a total of £4800 for the whole year (2022). Our income for the financial year was £4500 which was short of what would have been realised, so as you can see there was a shortfall of £300. Food items that were given out during the financial year was mainly brought in by members of the church.

None of the Trustees receive any pay as the Charity operates on voluntary basis until such time when it is well established then consideration will be given to hiring staff to manage the organisation. The church will continue to serve the community through creative awareness and moral training to impact the Youth and those that may fall within the scope of our umbrella.

The church offers prayer to the community, educate, and provide counselling opportunities to members of the community.

Higher Kingdon Church International is hopeful that the charity will grow and affect the community positively and impact lives in a more collaborative manner.

Among some of the activities the church play is radio broadcasting on Sundays, Community Outreach on Saturdays, Open door policy around counselling, Feeding the community once every 3 months and praying for the sick and infirmed.

It is our belief that the church will expand to start training and advising the youth in the local area. Once we have acquired our own property, then most of the activities would be indoors during winter and outdoor activities will comprise jogging, walking challenge and excursions to places of interest and prayer retreats.

Higher Kingdom Church International is hopeful that, the charity will grow to affect wider communities within the London area soon. Our Trustees are committed to supporting the church achieve its vision and reach out to vulnerable people in society with the gospel of Jesus Christ which brings hope, peace and love among humanity.

The Charity also visits people in the community to advice, support and provide guidance to as many that need support and accepting to make a difference in their lives.

Higher Kingdom church International is committed to broadcasting the gospel of Jesus on the air to inspire, encourage and embolden listeners to believe in God and to conform to the commandments, statutes and tenets of what Jesus Christ came to do in the world, thus to save his people from their misery and give them hope for the future. Other activities undertaken by the Charity include, feeding the poor and needy in the community once every month. Food substances are given out to members of the public occasionally to meet their needs.

So far, the Charity has not incurred any debts this year and funds that come in through members of the church are used to pay rent, support members who are in need, aid and support people who celebrate various anniversaries in their lives like birthdays, bereavements and other life events as the demand might be.

None of the trustees hold any funds of the charity as money and contributions that come in are deposited in the Charity's Business account as and when it is appropriate. Financial statements are provided periodically to the trustees, so they are aware of the income and expenditure of the company. The business account has two Signatories, Mr Samuel Quartey and Mr Joseph Kwaw who see to it that, any withdrawals for rent payments, support to members and buying of food items to help the community are done in an honest and transparent manner.

Higher Kingdom Church International is here to ensure that, people's lives are transformed by the word of God and that, morality and Christian ethics and values are inculcated in the lives of people in our community.

HIGHER KINGDOM CHURCH INTERNATIONAL: ANNUAL REPORT – 2019/20

NB: There has not been any significant change since 2019 and the report for 2019 is congruent with 2020. The pandemic really affected the organisation from meeting apart from virtual video calls and sporadic donations (food parcels) to the community.

The church has been doing well in the local community by providing counselling support, food parcels, visitation, and air broadcasting to encourage and advise people on safety and keeping well in their emotional wellbeing.

Higher Kingdom Church is interested in people living in the community and would from time to time visit them through evangelistic work, teachings about Jesus Christ and how to live and cohabit with neighbours in a peaceful environment.

The Church has demonstrated goodwill towards its members and assisted and supported them in areas of need, spiritual and cognitive development through Bible studies and prayers and other recreational phenomena. The pandemic has been quite difficult for most people and so physical interaction has not been easy and alternative ways of meeting has been the new normal in 2020.

The church has been quite vocal in supporting members who lost dear ones and relatives in the year and in some cases, financial contributions were made available to surviving children and family. I must say that, it has not been easy mobilising people or recruiting them into the church. Most often, people visit the church but after two or three appearances, they leave and do not come back again.

A lot of people who were supported financially and with prayers soon left after they received their healing and whatever, they came to church to grab, so it becomes very difficult to maintain a reasonable number of membership in the church.

The church moved its location from the City Mission's building in 2019 to St Margaret's and St George's United Reform and Monrovia building after we were told the previous building is going to be demolished in that year.

I must say that, our new location appears spacious with access to facilities that we were unable to get at the previous location. Fortunately, for the church the current location is found within Brent amid town so, access to the church is not difficult at all.

Higher Kingdom church has a slot on a radio station every Sunday morning, where it broadcast and presents topical issues around the gospel of Jesus Christ to its listeners. And feedback from our audience has been positive. The church therefore continues to provide spiritual and material support to the community so long as it operates within the jurisdiction of the United Kingdom.

Usually, the church is financed through the offerings and tithes of members which is used to pay the rent and support members when the need arises. The church does not receive any financial support apart from what the church receives when we gather on Sundays and as per government's guidelines.

No one receives wages or salary in Higher Kingdom as we all volunteer to support the community to attain spiritual and emotional stability in themselves and others who come into our attention. We visit hospitals like Northwick Park and others to pray in their Faith rooms for the sick to be healed.

The Higher Kingdom church is a dedicated charitable Organisation whose aim is to ensure that the community is impacted with message of Jesus Christ, whose aim is to bring salvation and peace

among all who come to his saving knowledge. It is a place, where wisdom is impacted to many and so, people find refuge and solace in the name of Jesus Christ, the son of the Living God.

Trustees are very happy about the church and are willing to support the ministry grow bigger and bigger and to accomplish its mission of saving lives and bringing the gospel of Jesus to everyone. Higher Kingdom church is accommodating, tolerable and able to assist everyone, regardless of race, gender, ethnicity and religion. However, the foundation of the ministry is to preach Christ and Him alone.
