Dogs arriving with not even the receiving the minimum Veterinary care, continues at an alarming rate. We have tried to help owners with these costs, in order for them to stay at home with their families if purely for financial reasons and by choice.
We continue to assist families with food, so that their dogs can be fed and kept within their family home rather than handed into rescue. Requests for help continue to rise on a daily basis.
We focus on that of public benefit and supporting the needs of individuals and their dogs.
Those dogs that require extra behavioural work to ensure their best hope of success in a new home, are given the time and patience they need.
We rarely have dogs that do not require support, for their wellbeing.

Volunteers have worked extremely hard both with fundraising and increasing administration needs. We have really tried to answer all requests for help, reach out to other rescues and put up posts for home from home cases providing rescue back up.

The increase in intakes with expensive veterinary needs has hugely increased and with the new XL Bully ban coming in, we have helped people exempt their dogs and made safe 5 of ours by exempting them and placing them in a beautiful sanctuary where they are very happy and safe.

We have provided food and help with vet bills to the public, to those that cannot afford it rather than the dogs being relinquished into kennels, where rehoming has decreased.

We have continued to help many dogs into loving homes and supported the new owners fully with their needs.



Our main focus again this year has been to ensure many dogs who really do not have much hope of a home are helped, because due to the Covid Puppy boom – easy to home dogs have been bred by the thousands pushing dogs with any issues to the bottom of the rehoming pile. Their chances of being put to sleep higher than ever.

Many of our dogs have behavioural issues and extra time is needed to ensure they are ready for a home. We do not allow dogs to go straight into homes, all homes are vetted and it is ensured they are suitable for each other.


