Para 1.17 and 1.19	Lincolnshire Lowland Search and Rescue (LLSAR) has continued to train to high standards set out by Lowland Rescue. We have 25 operational members, 11 Search Technicians in training, 2 Associate Members, 2 TAQAs, 2 search Managers, Search Planners and Operation Managers, 2 Team Leaders and 2 IQA's. We have undertaken 1220 man hours of searching; 634 man hours for Lincolnshire and Humberside police and 586 man hours assisting Nottinghamshire, South Yorkshire and Cambridgeshire Search and Rescue. We have undertaken 960 man hours on exercises, 249 man hours on training, 486 man hours on fundraising, 40 hours on recruiting, 56 man hours on Senior Management and Trustees meetings, and 211 man hours on other activities such as sorting an
