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TRUSTEES REPORT

The charity is governed and registered with the Charity Commission under the charity number 1167091

Objectives of the Charity:

The advancement of Christian Faith, empowerment of members and involvement in local communities as set out in the Charity's Article and Schedule, in accordance with the guidance issued by the Charity Commission for promoting the objects.

Achievements and Performance

The organization meets regularly for the promotion of the spiritual and physical wellbeing of members and the local communities. We Engage in missions directly and indirectly through collaborations with local and international charities for the alleviation of poverty. The Charity is actively involved in the activities of Churches Together in Northampton as well as with the Compassion UK through the sponsorship of 2 children. In addition, the Charity collaborates with other Charities, particularly other Churches within RCCG in the Area and across the Country.

The Charity also supports Youth empowerment through residential and non-residential training and provides Pastoral care and welfare support for them. The Charity provides coaching, discipleship and mentoring opportunities to the Youth as they transit into adulthood. The Children Department of the Charity provides opportunities for children and the Youth opportunities to express their God-given talents, giftings, skills and faith through nurturing, supporting, coaching and supervision.

The 2021 freshers' seminar for intending undergraduate students was organized in August 2021 with various guest speakers on various topics as Finance and budgeting, Mental health, Time management, etc.

In addition, recognizing the importance of stable homes in society, the Church undertakes regular marriage seminar/meetings for members as well as undertaking whole family activities within and outside of the regular meeting place. The belief of the Charity in the importance of stable families and homes as the bedrock of the Church and society informs the importance that it places on holistic atmosphere for families to flourish and prosper spiritually, physically, socially, and emotionally.

The Church moved back to physical gathering after the lifting of the Covid-19 restrictions on physical gatherings. The Church now meet physically for Sunday services and virtually for all midweek services/activities.

Governance and Internal Control

The Trustees have the general oversight of the activities of the Charity through the setting up of strategic directions for the Charity and meet statutorily twice a year to review and set directions for the Charity. While the day-to-day running of the Charity is undertaken by the Parish Pastor, the trustees are consulted as at and when required.

Financial Activities and Results

The net incoming resources for the year amounted to £30,019

Reserve Policy:

It is the policy of the charity to maintain unrestricted funds, which are reserves of the charity. This provides sufficient funds to cover any emergency expenditure that may arise from time to time.

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Risk Management

The charity has assessed all the major risks to which the charity is exposed to, in particular, those related to operation and finances of the charity and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to major risks.

Trustee Responsibilities

The Charity Act 2005 requires the trustees to prepare a statement of accounts for each accounting year which gives a true and fair view of the state of the church. They are required to.

1. Select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently.
2. Make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent.
3. State whether the applicable accounting standards have been followed.
4. Prepare financial statements on the going concern basis.

They are responsible for keeping proper records which disclose with reasonable accuracy of the finances of the church at any time and 'to ensure that such accounts comply with the Charities Act 1993. They also have responsibility to safeguard the assets of the church and to take reasonable steps to detect fraud or other irregularities.
