Report of the Trustees for the Year Ending 31st December 2024

The trustees present their report with the financial statements for the Charity for the year ending 31st December 2024. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to Charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 01st January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

AIM

Our aim is the prevention and relief of poverty to create an environment where they can lead a happy and healthy life.

OBJECTIVES

The objects of the Charity are set out in the Charity's Trust Deed and are summarised as follows; -

Providing and assisting in the provision of education, training and healthcare projects which will support the orphans and enable them to generate sustainable income eventually becoming self-sufficient.

To relieve the poverty of young people enabling them to participate in healthy, educational and recreational activities that were otherwise unaffordable.

STRATEGY

Our strategy for the achievement of these objects is to identify areas where emergency or priority help is required and then to start projects that will meet the needs of the orphans. We then fundraise for those projects and establish them on the ground with the help of volunteers. We assist and monitor the progress and delivery of the projects thereafter.

USE OF VOLUNTEERS

The trustees are developing a pool of volunteers to assist with their work. The trustees are extremely grateful for the efforts of the volunteers and the public who support our appeals and have undertaken the fundraising within their spare time to help those less fortunate.

Love4Orphans are putting in place a volunteer policy with due diligence and codes of conduct.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

How our activities deliver public benefit

In line with its own objects, the Charity continues to provide services and activities as summarised below. We help those who are affected through hardship to survive, and we look to better their lives in challenging circumstances.

RELIEF OF HARDSHIP ACTIVITIES

During the year under review, the Charity has supported orphans and extremely poor families in the Sylhet district of Bangladesh by providing food and clothing. During the period under review, the Charity has also supported the purchase of land in Mauritania to help with the development of an orphanage and school.

FUTURE PLANS

The Charity will look to continue raising funds, spending the monies raised to provide support and aid to the poorer families, widows and orphans in the Sylhet district of Bangladesh.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing Document

LOVE4ORPHANS INTERNATIONAL CHARITABLE TRUST is constituted as a Charitable Trust registered with the Charity Commission on 07th June 2016 under Charity Number 116752. It is governed by a constitution adopted on 22nd May 2016.

RECRUITMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF NEW TRUSTEES

There are four trustees. The existing trustees are responsible for the recruitment of new trustees and will appoint additional trustees as required.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Organisational Structure

The trustees of the Charity are responsible for the management and general control of the Charity. The trustees receive no remuneration or financial benefits and give their time freely.

The trustees convene meetings on a regular basis and are responsible for decisions taken in relations to the day-to-day running and ongoing activities of the Charity. The Chairman is actively involved in the running of projects supported by the other trustees and volunteers.

Induction and Training of New Trustees

The trustees have established a process of induction and training for the current and any future trustees in accordance with its trust deed.


PRINCIPAL FUNDING SOURCES

Independent Examiners Statement


I have completed my examination. I confirm that no material matters have come to my attention in connection with the examination giving cause to believe that in any material respect:

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS For the year ending 31st December 2024

1) ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the Charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS102 have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) "Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)". Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the Charity has entitlement to the funds; it is probable that the income will be received, and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the Charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all costs related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to headings, they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The Charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for restricted purposes within the objects of the Charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
