Activities this year included the Summer fair, Christmas fair, school discos, Easter egg hunt, bingo nights and other events.. This year the PSA contributed £7,111 to the school which included £4,112 for a new lectern, token tube collectors, Virgin Mary marble garden statue, display boards, school shop supplies and end of year awards, £952 for playground equipment and educational books, and £1,876 for school workshops for the children.

At the end of the year income reserves amounted to £40,280. The PSA's policy on reserves is to hold funds readily available to support the school and the PSA has committed to funding a program to buy a new school minibus.

The accounts have been drawn up on a receipts and payments basis which is consistent with the previous year.
