Through the grace of Allah our provision of emergency relief aid was sent to Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Palestine and the Uighur refugees in Turkey this year.

We built 4 more water dams in Mali, continued with construction of village in Syria.

We sponsored 2 Schools in Albania.

Provided support to locals within London area in need of financial support (mostly refugees).
