Objects: THE OBJECTS OF THE CIO ARE:• TO HELP PREVENT OR RELIEVE POVERTY IN THE UK AND DR CONGO BY PROVIDING: GRANTS, ITEMS AND SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS IN NEED AND/OR CHARITIES, OR OTHER ORGANISATIONS WORKING TO PREVENT OR RELIEVE POVERTY• TO RELIEVE POVERTY [OR FINANCIAL HARDSHIP] AMONG ORPHANS BETWEEN 0-16 YEARS OF AGE AND THEIR DEPENDANTS LIVING IN THE UK AND DR CONGO [OR ANYWHERE IN THE WORLD] BY PROVIDING OR ASSISTING IN THE PROVISION OF EDUCATION, TRAINING, HEALTHCARE, ADVOCACY, SHELTER AND FOOD• TO RELIEVE THE POVERTY OF YOUNG PEOPLE BY THE PROVISION OF GRANTS TO ENABLE THEM TO PARTICIPATE IN HEALTHY RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES THAT THEY COULD NOT OTHERWISE AFFORD• THE RELIEF OF SICKNESS AND THE PRESERVATION OF HEALTH AMONG YOUNG PEOPLE RESIDING PERMANENTLY IN THE UK AND/OR DR CONGO• THE RELIEF OF UNEMPLOYMENT FOR OVER 16-21 YEAR OLDS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC IN SUCH WAYS AS MAY BE THOUGHT FIT, INCLUDING ASSISTANCE TO FIND EMPLOYMENT• TO PROMOTE SOCIAL INCLUSION FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT BY PREVENTING YOUNG PEOPLE FROM BECOMING SOCIALLY EXCLUDED AND ASSISTING THEM TO INTEGRATE INTO SOCIETY. FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS CLAUSE 'SOCIALLY EXCLUDED' MEANS BEING EXCLUDED FROM SOCIETY, OR PARTS OF SOCIETY, AS A RESULT OF ONE OF MORE OF THE FOLLOWING FACTORS: ILL HEALTH (PHYSICAL OR MENTAL); DISCRIMINATION ON THE GROUNDS OF SEX, RACE, DISABILITY, POOR EDUCATIONAL OR SKILLS ATTAINMENT OR AS A RESULT OF BEING AN ORPHAN• TO ACT AS A RESOURCE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE UP TO THE AGE OF 21 LIVING IN THE UK AND DR CONGO BY PROVIDING ADVICE AND ASSISTANCE AND ORGANISING PROGRAMMES OF PHYSICAL, EDUCATIONAL AND OTHER ACTIVITIES AS A MEANS OF: (A) ADVANCING IN LIFE AND HELPING YOUNG PEOPLE BY DEVELOPING THEIR SKILLS, CAPACITIES AND CAPABILITIES TO ENABLE THEM TO PARTICIPATE IN SOCIETY AS INDEPENDENT, MATURE AND RESPONSIBLE INDIVIDUALS; (B) ADVANCING EDUCATION; (C) RELIEVING UNEMPLOYMENT; (D) PROVIDING RECREATIONAL AND LEISURE TIME ACTIVITY IN THE INTERESTS OF SOCIAL WELFARE FOR PEOPLE LIVING IN THE AREA OF BENEFIT WHO HAVE NEED BY REASON OF THEIR YOUTH, AGE, INFIRMITY OR DISABILITY, POVERTY OR SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC CIRCUMSTANCES WITH A VIEW TO IMPROVING THE CONDITIONS OF LIFE OF SUCH PERSONS.

Activities: The Afobe Foundation primarily operates to support disadvantaged and vulnerable young people including orphans and disabled children in DR Congo and the UK.

OUR AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

To help prevent or relieve poverty in the UK and the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) by providing grants, items and services to individual in need and / or charities or other organizations.

To relieve poverty among orphans between the ages of 0-16 and their Dependants in the UK and the DRC by providing or assisting in the provision of education, training, healthcare, advocacy, shelter and food.

To help relieve poverty and preserve health among young people in the UK and the DRC.

To help relieve unemployment for 16-21 year olds by assisting with finding employment.

To promote social exclusion by assisting 16-21 year olds with integration in society.

To provide advice, assistance and organise programmes of physical activities.

REVIEW OF ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS

- During this year funds were available from from our trustees to run most of our activities. Our income was not very high to achieve all our targeted service.
- But we did spend time to publicise our works to the public such as Information Displays for children and young people.
- We have offered general advice and if necessary, referrals on some issues.
- We did manage to run our services (by providers) by telephone, email, visiting on appointment.

1 - We have also offered general advice for 16-21 year olds and if necessary provided referrals on the following issues which our clients might experience:

- Education
- Training
- Unemployment
- Poverty
- Healthcare
- Advocacy
- Shelter and food (through churches)
- Housing
- Physical health through sport
- We have also provided advice on orphans 0-16 years of age and their dependants living in the UK.

2- Assistance to find employment.

3- Assist them to integrate into UK society.

4- We have a bank of interpreters that assist our clients who are struggling in English (language difficulties).

5- We have organised a team of volunteers who offer their time to support our services.

We could not make grants to our clients, whether individuals or charities nor provide buildings or hall facilities.

We tried to help people in need during Covid-19 with the help of some volunteers.

We tried to raise awareness in personal hygiene and healthcare in all group of people.
