CARERS AND EDUCATIONALISTS) AT WEST SPECIAL SCHOOL, CHWELE, WESTERN PROVINCE, KENYA OR ELSEWHERE IN KENYA BY DEVELOPING AN ETHICAL FRAMEWORK FOR THE COMMUNITY AND CONTRIBUTING TOWARDS A BETTER SOCIETY, FOR EXAMPLE, BY PROMOTING SOCIAL COHESION AND SOCIAL CAPITAL.
