

During the year, the Trust received a Draft Heads of Terms document from Devon Council for the transfer the building to the Trust. The Trustees considered this in October, and came to the view that the terms were unacceptable as they stood. The chairman resigned as he felt that the project should be abandoned in view of this, and of other changes including the Covid pandemic. The remaining Trustees agreed to continue negotiating with DCC.



A Draft Heads of Terms document for the transfer the building to the Parish Council was received from Devon County Council. The document was discussed by the PC in June. The PC declined the proposal as it does not want direct ownership of the premises, but remained supportive of the Trust's efforts.

The Trust then engaged with Devon Historic Buildings Trust to put forward a second proposal to DCC which would see the building transferred directly to the Trust instead. Documents supporting this proposal were in preparation at the year's end.
