AIM & OBJECTIVE

Special Children's Trust UK aims to reach out in love, offer hope and restore dignity to children with special needs in East Africa.

This is achieved by accepting donations and child sponsorships from individuals mainly in the UK, USA and Germany, which is then distributed to those in need. We operate with the mandate to raise awareness of the plight of children with special needs and to raise funds to support the practical work done by organizations and charities based in East Africa.

ACTIVITIES & PARTNERSHIP

The charity we are currently working with is Special Children's Trust in Uganda. Our role includes:

- **Child sponsorship** – We raise awareness of children in Uganda with special needs who need to be sponsored for education and wellbeing. The school we are working with is Dawn Children's Centre in Kampala, where children with and without special needs who vary in their stages of development, learn together. Individuals who decide to sponsor make monthly payments into the account, which is then transferred to SCT Uganda twice a year (June/November). Our sponsors receive yearly updates and photos of the child they are sponsoring. This year the charity has been able to sponsor twelve children in a Ugandan organisation under the umbrella of Special Children's Trust Uganda.
- **Project donations** – SCT UK accepts donations on behalf of non-profit organizations like SCT UG. In 2024, we received a donation of £30 from Christ Church towards the Forever Home project.
- **Face-painting** – Our charity was used to receive restricted funds that were used to buy face paints to sent to Uganda for their annual special need's awareness day in Kampala, Uganda.

As a charity however, there are also other financial roles such as:

- **General donations** – donations are received by the public with the aim to fulfil our mission. In 2024, we received a number of donations that we decided to use towards the cost of postage. Three boxes full of sensory equipment and toys for children with special needs were sent to Uganda and the decision was made to use general funds towards the purpose of covering the postage cost.
- **CFS School Fair and Craft Sale** – An annual school fair takes place before the school Christmas break at Christian fellowship school in Liverpool. Tracey and Theodora Sammons take this opportunity to sell bric-a-brac and baked good in order to raise money for SCT UK.

Donations are also received during this event. This year, they were able to raise a total of £227.

- **Amazon Smile** – We received no donations from Amazon Smile this year.
- **PayPal** – Some donations are made via PayPal. We are trying to change this however, so that funds are received directly into the Barclays bank account. This is so that the charity receives the payment directly and the name and payment track is clear.

FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

The charity had to make three sponsorship payments during 2024. The Sponsorship payment due the previous year was delayed and was made in January of 2024 instead. This is shown clearly in the financial report; CC16.

The majority of cost is attributed to postage and sponsorship payments.

The charity set up an Active Saver account in 2017. The purpose of this account is to accrue interest on unrestricted funds transferred from the main account. In 2018, £1,900 was transferred into the savings account. Some funds were removed from the account during this financial year to cover postage costs. The Active Saver holds £680 as of the end of 2024. This fund is for the charity to use as and when necessary, in agreement with all trustees.

The charity is succeeding in meeting its financial obligations and purposes.

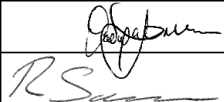

We operate with the mandate to raise awareness of the plight of children with special needs and to raise funds to support the practical work done by organizations and charities based in East Africa.

ACTIVITIES & PARTNERSHIP

The charity we are currently working with is Special Children's Trust in Uganda. Our role includes:

- **Child sponsorship** – We raise awareness of children in Uganda with special needs who need to be sponsored for education and wellbeing. The school we are working with is Dawn Children's Centre in Kampala, where children with and without special needs who vary in their stages of development, learn together. Individuals who decide to sponsor make monthly payments into the account, which is then transferred to SCT Uganda twice a year (June/November). Our sponsors receive yearly updates and photos of the child they are sponsoring. This year the charity has been able to sponsor eleven children in a Ugandan organisation under the umbrella of Special Children's Trust Uganda.
- **Project donations** – SCT UK accepts donations on behalf of non-profit organizations like SCT UG. In 2023, we received a donation of £30 from Christ Church towards the Forever Home project.

As a charity however, there are also other financial roles such as:

- **General donations** – donations are received by the public with the aim to fulfil our mission. In 2023, we received a total of £195 general donations for the charity to use.
- **CFS School Fair** – An annual school fair takes place before the school Christmas break at Christian fellowship school in Liverpool. Tracey and Theodora Sammons take this opportunity to sell bric-a-brac and baked good in order to raise money for SCT UK. Donations are also received during this event. This year, they were able to raise a total of £108.50.
- **Parcels** – the charity uses donations to purchase sensory toys and books for special needs children in Uganda. In 2023, boxes were sent via Parcel Hero and Lontex to Kampala full of

sensory toys and equipment for children, which were then used in schools for therapy and practical training. The cost of delivery is covered by donations made to the charity specifically for post, with the shortfall covered by general donations.

- **Amazon Smile** – Amazon Smile works in partnership with SCT to raise a small percentage of profit every time a buyer makes a purchase online. In 2023, we were able to raise £20.35.

FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

The charity had an income of £3,827.

The total expenditure of the charity is £1,913. The majority of cost is attributed to postage and sponsorship payments. The reason behind the fact that the expenditure is less than usual is due to the fact that there has been a delay in sending the November sponsorship payment to SCT UG. This has been done in January 2024 and will be covered in the next financial report.

The charity set up an Active Saver account in 2017. The purpose of this account is to accrue interest on unrestricted funds transferred from the main account. In 2018, £1,900 was transferred into the savings account. No funds were removed from the account during this financial year. The Active Saver holds £780 as of the end of 2023. This fund is for the charity to use as and when necessary.

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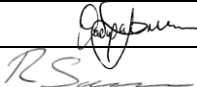

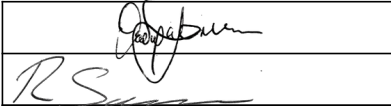

 - **Parcels** – the charity uses donations to purchase sensory toys and books for special needs children in Uganda. In 2021, boxes were sent via Parcel Hero and Lontex to Kampala full of

FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

The charity had an income of £4,422 with an additional £910 carried forward from 2020.

The total expenditure of the charity is £4,620. The majority of cost is attributed to postage and sponsorship payments.

The charity set up an Active Saver account in 2017. The purpose of this account is to accrue interest on unrestricted funds transferred from the main account. In 2018, £1,900 was transferred into the savings account. In 2021, £166.05 was withdrawn from the account to cover one postage delivery payment to the Lontex Exports Ltd company. The Active Saver holds £764 as of the end of 2021. This fund is for the charity to use as and when necessary.

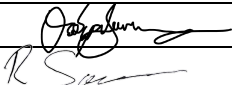

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This is achieved by accepting donations and child sponsorships from individuals mainly in the UK, USA and Germany, which is then distributed to those in need. We operate with the mandate to raise awareness of the plight of children with special needs and to raise funds to support the practical work done by organizations and charities based in East Africa.

ACTIVITIES & PARTNERSHIP

The charity we are currently working with is Special Children's Trust in Uganda. Our role includes:

- **Child sponsorship** – We raise awareness of children in Uganda with special needs who need to be sponsored for education and wellbeing. The school we are working with is Dawn Children's Centre in Kampala, where children with and without special needs who vary in their stages of development, learn together. Individuals who decide to sponsor make monthly payments into the account, which is then transferred to SCT Uganda twice a year (June/November). Our sponsors receive yearly updates and photos of the child they are sponsoring.
- **Project donations** – SCT UK accepts donations on behalf of non-profit organizations like SCT UG. In 2020 we received donations towards the construction of a new mobility hub in Kampala, Uganda, and Christmas hampers that were assembled and distributed to struggling families with special needs children. The charity also received a large donation of £3,522.08 from the USA specifically for the Forever Home project.

As a charity however, there are also other financial roles such as:

- **General donations** – donations are received by the public with the aim to fulfill our mission. In 2020 these general donations were used to support special needs families who were suffering as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic. An announcement was also shared in order to raise awareness and collect donations specifically for these families.
- **Parcels** – the charity uses donations to purchase sensory toys and books for special needs children in Uganda. In 2020, boxes were sent via Parcel Hero and Lontex to Kampala full of

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sensory toys and equipment for children, which were then used in schools for therapy and practical training. The cost of delivery is covered by donations made to the charity specifically for post, with the shortfall covered by general donations.

- **Amazon Smile** – Amazon Smile works in partnership with SCT to raise a small percentage of profit every time a buyer makes a purchase online. In 2020, we were able to raise £11.02.

CONCLUSION

The charity is succeeding in meeting its financial obligations and purposes.
