

Trustees' Report

year ending 31st December 2024

We were able to hold the popular 'Blade Sharpening Event'. We also held three Events which were well attended and popular. Together they raised £2,137.51. We have therefore finished the year in a healthy position even though the cash balance is slightly down.

To build our cash position, to enable us to meet any future requests for support from the PCC, we changed the investment in one of the CCLA funds to income rather than accumulation. This produced an income in the year of £1,167.96. Now that our cash position is satisfactory this has now been invested in The CCLA Global Equity Fund.

No donations were requested or made by the PCC but we have agreed to consider any requests following the next Quinquennial Report.

We made a donation to the Bells Appeal for St. George's Church restoration and re- hanging of the Bells of the Church of £5,000.

Huge thanks to all those who arranged the various successful Events: 'Blade Sharpening Event'; the final sale of the 'Mini Jigsaw Puzzles'; the Dhalia Festival and the Isaac Newton Talk.
