The advancement and education of children from vulnerable and impoverished backgrounds through a) the provision of sponsorship for school fees b) providing the necessary school supplies and resources, c) guidance and support for the children during the primary and secondary school education. Considerations will be made on a case by case basis regarding whether support will continue into higher education.

Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objects (include within this section the statutory declaration that trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit)

A decent standard of education provided for children within Kibera whose parents/guardians would have otherwise struggled to provide the necessary funds for the children to complete their primary and secondary school education and further education. The organisation aims to provide the children under its sponsorship with the opportunity to shape their own future by obtaining an education which is very much required in Kenya if they are to exit the 'poverty trap' which those within Kibera generally experience.

The direct beneficiaries of this organisation are the children within primary and secondary school and higher education whose education is paid for. The indirect beneficiaries are their families who can focus on providing food and shelter for the children with the knowledge that their education has been funded. Additionally, Kickstart Kibera hopes that other children within Kibera will feel motivated and inspired by seeing their peers who are from similar backgrounds to them, with the opportunity to advance their education.

The trustees have all helped to run Kickstart Kibera on a volunteer basis. We have also had two further volunteers that have helped with our logo, website and social media to try to bring awareness to the work of Kickstart Kibera.

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

We have paid fees for 5 students – 1 student in college, 2 students completing post secondary school vocational courses, 1 student in secondary school and 1 student in primary school.

The student in college completed their course in Social Work and Community Development at the end of 2023 with a distinction achieved. This top grade was achieved by just 6 other students out of the 101 students on the course. The student had internship opportunities during the course, providing her with crucial work experience and increasing her likelihood of obtaining a job after completion of the course. Kickstart Kibera paid for the student's lodging and college fees during this course.

1 of the 2 students completing post secondary school vocational courses completed a diploma in beauty therapy. The other student completed an IT course alongside training in key Microsoft packages and attended an art school.

The 1 student in secondary school is a new student sponsored by Kickstart Kibera in 2023.

The 1 primary school student finished primary school in 2023 and we have decided to continue sponsoring them into secondary school in 2024.
