2024 proved to be another exciting year for the Safari Simbaz charity. Key highlights include:

1. Our support to the Safari Simbaz in Kenya has continued to help fund youth training/education enabling them to learn discipline, teamwork, and resilience. They continue to build confidence and gain the required skills for adulthood.
2. Fundraising has been fairly stable throughout 2024 but sufficient to meet the annual requirement. The focus on our fundraising will need to be increased over the next couple of years while we endeavour to assist an increasing number of Kenyan youth.
3. Nick Bourne, a co-founder of Safari Simbaz Charity Trust (Europe), resigned from the trustee role during 2024 to focus on work & family. We thank Nick for the great voluntary work he has done for the charity and wish him the very best for the future.
4. Andrew de Rozairo & David Wood have joined as new trustees after being introduced by David Kinjah when they participated in a 'Ride Africa' cycling safari where some of the 'Simbaz' were assisting in the running of the event. Both Andrew and David bring excellent additional professional skills to our charity.

This year has seen the youth supported by Safari Simbaz engaged in a few more cycling related activities that gradually lead to them become more self-supporting through raising funds locally in Kenya.

The trustees look forward to ongoing fundraising and activities gaining further momentum towards expanding the number of youth we can assist.

SAFARI SIMBAZ CHARITY TRUSTEES REPORT – Year ending 31st December, 2023

2023 proved to be another exciting year for the Safari Simbaz charity. Key highlights include:

1. In February, Nick Bourne (Trustee) attempted to beat the world solo unsupported cycling record from Cairo to Cape Town. After phenomenal distances being covered by Nick in the first few days (well on target to beat the record), conditions became so dangerous in Sudan that the attempt had to be abandoned (initial fundraising retained).
2. Chris Froome (originally trained to ride by David Kinjah and always maintained a keen interest in the Safari Simbaz) joined our Trustees Meeting in June and was confirmed as 'Ambassador' to the Safari Simbaz Charity.
3. During August we made the final payment for the 5 acres of land purchased near Mount Kenya where we intend to establish the new and much needed base for assisting the under-privileged youth in Kenya. Registration of the land in the name of Safari Simbaz Trust (Kenya) was in progress at the end of 2023.

Significant further fundraising is now required to build the 'Academy' on the land which will provide both accommodation & educational facilities for the youth supported by Safari Simbaz plus additional features enabling the centre to gradually become self-supporting though offering cycling related services/tours to visitors.

The trustees look forward to ongoing fundraising and activities gaining further momentum to enable progress with the proposed 'Academy'.

SAFARI SIMBAZ CHARITY TRUSTEES REPORT – Year ending 31st December, 2022

2022 proved to be quite a major milestone year for the Safari Simbaz charity. Thanks to a major donation our charity received total donations of £77,733 during the year. This enabled us to contribute £71,140 towards the purchase of 5 acres of land near Mount Kenya where the new and much needed base for assisting the under-privileged youth in Kenya is to be built. We are intending to provide the final 10% for the land purchase in 2023, the land will then be registered in the name of Safari Simbaz Trust (Kenya).

The land purchase is a first step towards replacing the existing rented accommodation & operational base for the Safari Simbaz Trust. The existing base in Kikuyu (on the outskirts of Nairobi, Kenya) is on a small plot and consists of several rented corrugated tin buildings with few utilities. Apart from the poor condition, there is also uncertainty over how much longer the current base will be available for rental.



Following the purchase of land, the next phase requires significant further fundraising to build the 'Academy' on the land which will provide both accommodation & educational facilities for the youth supported by Safari Simbaz plus additional features enabling the centre to gradually become self-supporting though offering cycling related services/tours to visitors.

The trustees look forward to ongoing fundraising and activities gaining significant momentum in 2023/2024.

SAFARI SIMBAZ CHARITY TRUSTEES REPORT - 31st December, 2021

As we progress out of the Covid Pandemic there has been limited activity within the Safari Simbaz charity but at the same time some significant progress. In terms of fundraising, funds received have continued as in previous years plus two significant donations worthy of special mention. The first was a donation of £750.64 from Kings School in Bruton (Somerset, UK) where the children participated in a sponsored cycling event. The second was a very generous donation of £11,000 for the deposit on land purchase in Kenya as a first step towards establishing a new and much needed base for assisting the under-privileged youth in Kenya. We are pleased to be able to confirm that as at 31st October 2022, as a result of further donations in the year following these accounts, the charity was able to raise further donations to complete the purchase of this land valued at £107,600.

In respect of financial operation, whilst retaining CashPlus as our main UK bank account, in September we opened an on-line WISE account to enable funds to be paid directly in Kenyan shillings for any costs incurred in Kenya (CashPlus account does not permit payments to be made outside of UK).

As mentioned earlier, we have in 2021 provided the funds for the deposit on a piece of land in Kenya that will subsequently be developed to provide accommodation and living space for the youth supported in Kenya by the Safari Simbaz. We anticipate 2022/2023 being particularly busy for the Safari Simbaz charity supporting the land purchase and ongoing development.

The trustees look forward to ongoing fundraising and activities gaining significant momentum in 2022/2023.
