Breed Specific Dog Rescue

Once again, this has been a very busy period for our rescue. As in previous years, we have been inundated with calls, emails, and applications via social media with requests to take in unwanted dogs. Although we have tried our best to help most of the dogs needing rescue, sadly due to lack of funding and space we have not always been able to help. However, we have worked with other rescues to help provide placements. We have supported local authorities and also Battersea dog home.

We have also suffered online trolling and abuse which seems to be a recurring theme these days, it certainly is not acceptable and does more harm to the dogs, we try to rise above it and carry on giving our time and huge efforts voluntarily.

We remain a breed specific rescue and we continue to rely on public donations for our main source of funding. However, many of our members arrange fundraising events and generously pass on any donations raised. The website with the charity's information with descriptions/requirements on the available dogs does require some updating which we will be addressing, but it has been the main source of contact with many using the online access to apply or surrender a dog.

The charity remains fully insured in accordance with the legal requirements.

Our main source of support for the dogs are kennels, and we have a wonderful support network at our boarding facilities in Rotherham. These kennels are privately owned and therefore the bulk of our income is used for payment for the service they provide. The kennels provide a safe environment for our dogs, with assessment and exercise to prepare them for future rehoming. We also have an account with the veterinary services linked to the kennels for any of the dogs' medical needs.

We have a small foster base which is expanding gradually, which allows the assessed dogs in kennels to be placed in suitable environments to progress with their rehabilitation. As always we offer support for these placements and any medical needs which may arise.

In the last year we have taken on fewer dogs due to the costs involved and lack of spaces, 8 of these are in foster homes whilst 24 remain in boarding facilities waiting for suitable homes, 4 have pending applications and should hopefully be moving to the new homes in the next few weeks, with the remaining 9 rehomed. Sadly, applications are still very slow due to current financial climate, often many are time wasters or unsuitable applicants for the breed specific requirements.

Moving forward our aim is to continue to increase our foster based numbers and reduce the numbers in kennel. This would have a huge impact on our finances and help reduce the large monthly bills.

Whilst we have many generous and wonderful supporters, we often struggle to raise the required funds each month and trustees use their own funds to help towards the shortfall. We would also like the government to look at legislation regarding the breeding of domestic pets as we believe under the current climate, facilities will be constantly overwhelmed with unwanted dogs especially bull breeds and unless something is done, young healthy dogs will continue to be euthanised every week due to the huge numbers being handed in and abandoned daily.

We strive to help as many dogs as possible. However, the need for funding is always a priority and we are always looking for new ideas to help us continue our voluntary work.
