During the period the charity also received specific donations for a number of projects including continued support of student's education, health promotion and towards the building of a church.

A grant of £3,000 was made from the general reserves to school in Tanzania in the year to allow improvement works to be undertaken on the classrooms.

At the year end restricted funds for specific projects amounted to £4,530 and will continue to be used for the designated purposes after the year end.

Towards the end of the year four new Trustees joined the charity bringing a variety of skills to the board. The new skills and ideas that they bring will allow the charity to increase its activities and generate the vital funds needed to support those in need in Tanzania.
