WE ALSO USED A LOCAL BUSINESS TO CARVE THE SCHOOL'S MASCOT (BANKS BEE) ON A FALLEN TREE STUMP NEAR THE ENTRANCE OF THE SCHOOL. THIS PROJECT SYMBOLISED THE SCHOOL'S COMMITMENT TO PARTNERING WITH LOCAL BUSINESS AND MANAGING OUR ECOLOGICAL IMPACT.

IN THIS YEAR, WE ALSO STARTED SAVING UP TO RENNOVATE SCHOOL'S ADVENTURE TRAIL AND UPGRADE IT. THE FUNDS WERE SUCCESSFULLY COLLECTED AND EVENTUALLY A NEW ADVENTURE TRAIL WAS INSTALLED IN AUG 2022 (CHARITY'S FOLLOWING TAX RETURNS YEAR).

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
