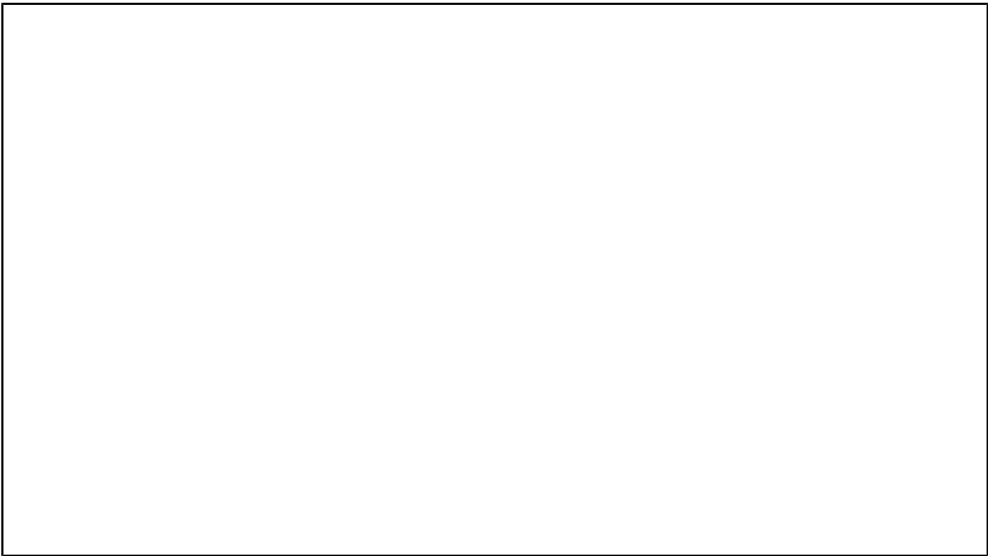

## Financial review

We hold cash at Barclays Bank of £2,380 of which £500 is restricted fund. We hold these funds to carryout community events, activities, rent venues and to meet any unforeseen expenditure.

We aim to hold at least £600 and no more than £8,000 in reserves at the year end.

\*The amount £500 is a grant funding from Nottingham Equal that we brought forward from 2019 year end - the amount was for a community event scheduled in 2020 and had been postponed due to the Coronavirus Pandemic.
