CEF PURPOSE

Activities

We remain committed to voluntarily teaching and supporting the learning of Arabic for a deeper understanding of the Quran. Our organization has not employed any paid staff, whether part-time or full-time. This approach has allowed us to minimize costs and concentrate our efforts on volunteers who deliver the courses.



We maintained a focused delivery of structured educational programs to deepen understanding of the Qur'an and Salah, ensuring accessibility across varied learner profiles. During this year, we successfully delivered three cohorts of the "Understand Quran and Salah" program, each consisting of 19 structured lessons, with refined pedagogy and enhanced learner engagement mechanisms.

West London – Intensive Weekend Program

The program was delivered over two intensive weekends, continuing the in-person, high-impact model suited for professionals and students with constrained schedules. Sessions incorporated interactive exercises, guided reflection, and applied learning techniques, strengthening both Quranic Arabic comprehension and the internalisation of Salah.

Birmingham

In Birmingham, it was delivered over 3 weekend sessions. The community-based environment supported peer interaction and sustained attendance, contributing to a more reflective and consistent learning experience.

Swansea – Evening Sessions

In Swansea, the program was conducted over 10 structured evening sessions, maintaining a paced and reflective learning environment. The community-based delivery supported consistent attendance, deeper engagement, and peer learning, contributing to both knowledge acquisition and community cohesion.

Zoom Online Classes

The online cohort followed a 10-week format with two 1-hour sessions per week. The virtual delivery model expanded reach to a broader demographic, including international participants. Enhanced use of interactive tools supported engagement, discussion, and retention, while maintaining flexibility for learners balancing personal and professional commitments.

Impact and Feedback

Across all delivery formats, participants demonstrated measurable improvement in Quranic Arabic understanding, Salah quality, and overall spiritual engagement. The structured curriculum, consistent delivery standards, and learner-centred approach contributed to strong outcomes. Participant feedback highlighted increased confidence, clarity in prayer, and demand for progression pathways, including intermediate-level programs.

Financials 2024-25

CEF is in a transitional phase and did not raise any funds from the public at large. The expenses of the Charity were limited only to office administration.

Chapter: Educational Initiatives - Quran and Salah Courses

We prioritized delivering educational programs to enhance understanding of the Quran and Salah, benefiting participants from diverse backgrounds. Over the past year, we completed three courses of "Understand Quran and Salah," each with 19 lessons, tailored for accessibility and impact.

East London - Intensive Weekend Program The course was conducted over two weekends, offering in-person, interactive sessions ideal for busy professionals and students. This hands-on format effectively taught Quranic Arabic and the spiritual essence of Salah.

Swansea - Evening Sessions In Swansea, lessons spanned 10 evenings, offering a gradual, reflective learning experience. Held in a community setting, the sessions enriched participants' understanding and fostered communal bonds.

Zoom Online Classes The online format included two 1-hour weekly sessions over 10 weeks, enabling participants worldwide to join. Zoom's interactive features replicated in-person learning, offering flexibility and inclusivity for those with family or work commitments.

Impact and Feedback Participants across all formats reported significant improvements in Quranic Arabic, Salah, and faith connection. The structured curriculum, skilled instructors, and interactive methods ensured a transformative experience, with many requesting advanced courses.

- UQ-Level-1 course London dates (SAT 14-05-23, SUN 15-02-23, SAT 21-05-23 and SUN 22-05-23).

Online

We were able to deliver following courses free via Zoom.

Trustees Report: 1st April 2021 to 31st March 2022

Our main charity activity is in providing courses, support and guidance on learning Arabic to understand Qur'an. The engagement with Mosques and education centres continues to be impacted by the effects of COVID. Live courses and teacher training has been difficult to provide. Many centres and volunteers are struggling with increased costs and are unable to host our courses.

Our volunteers have delivered limited number of courses:

- Understand Qur'an and Salah the easy way (Level-1): was delivered in 2 live sessions at local Mosques: Sept 2021 and Feb 2022.
- Level-1: Arabic of Salah date: Aug 2021
- Level-2: Study of Surah Al-Baqarah: Jan 2022

Charity Income and Expenses:

We do not employ any paid staff, part-time or full-time. This has helped us in minimising our costs and focus on volunteers delivering courses. This year the charity did not need to spend any funds nor was involved in any fund-raising activities

The Impact of COVID lockdown resulted us not being able to actively promote the work of the Charity. Since Mar 2020, we have not been able to host live courses, provide resources for teaching or delivery teacher training program.

We do not employ any paid staff, part-time or full-time. This has helped us in minimising our costs and focus on volunteers delivering courses.

Online courses

We were able to deliver following courses free via Zoom.

- Understand Qur'an and Salah the easy way (Level-1): this course 19 hours was delivered on 3 occasions. These were delivered 3 times a week on one-hour sessions.
- Surah Baqarah Page 1 to 5 (Level-2) was delivered on two occasions, a course of 20 lessons.
- Surah Baqarah Page 6 to 10 (Level-3) was delivered on one occasion, a course of 20 lessons.

Charity Income and Expenses:
