Structure, Governance and Management

Wake Up and Help was registered as a **Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO)** on **29 November 2016** with the Charity Commission for England and Wales under **charity number 1170447**.

The charity is governed by its **constitution**, which outlines how it operates and how decisions are made.

Objects and Activities

Wake Up and Help is established **for the public benefit** in the UK and India, with the following charitable objectives:

2. **The prevention or relief of poverty** by providing grants, items and services to individuals in need and/or charities or other organisations working to prevent or relieve poverty.
 3. **The relief of sickness and the preservation of health** through the provision of financial assistance, support, education and practical advice.
 4. **To advance the Hindu religion** through the holding of prayer meetings, lectures, public celebration of religious festivals, and by producing and/or distributing literature on Hinduism to enlighten others about the faith.

Significant Activities in 2024

During the year ended 31 December 2024, the charity continued to carry out activities supporting its charitable objectives, including:

- Operating a **book bank**, providing literature on Indian culture and heritage to the public, with continued growth in use.
 - Organising **free food distribution** to support homeless and needy individuals.
 - Distributing **warm clothing and blankets** during the winter months to vulnerable people in **London**
 - Strengthening **collaborations** with local charities, community organisations, and members of the public to extend the charity's reach and impact.
 - Supporting **community education projects** aimed at preserving Indian arts, music, and language heritage.
 - Held community gatherings in the Redbridge area to serve elderly
