Para 1.17 and 1.19	<p>StopSO continues to offer therapy to those in in need of help and support in relation to sexual offending.</p> <p>The increase of referrals has continued, and we find that as StopSO grows these referrals from other agencies (e.g. Police and Social Services) continues to increase.</p> <p>In addition, we have found that StopSO is being approached more often for media related enquiries and support/training about prevention of sexual offending (e.g. working within in schools to raise awareness of sexual offending/consent etc)</p> <p>We have taken on a Business Development Manager who has been proactive in seeking funding for StopSO so that we can continue to advance the work we do within the Community.</p> <p>The StopSO network of Therapists continues to remain strong and enables us to offer therapists all over the UK.</p>

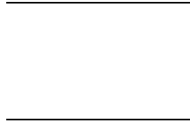
