Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

Over the seventh year of running as a charity, we have now distributed over 500,000 awareness cards around England and Wales. This has been achieved via requests from our website.

Due to Covid 19 we have seen a drop in requests for our cards and the need to have a better on line presence, made us decide to invest in a new website which could be viewed on all devices.

We continued to see a drop in engagement over 2023, so we decided to engage with Target Ovarian Cancer to see if they would be interested in absorbing our charity and distributing our awareness cards as we have about 200,000 left. They were not interested, so an action plan on how to get our cards out with minimal expenses was created which we plan to action in January 2024.
