The Trustees present their report and the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2022.

Governing Instrument:

Dagenham East Education Centre (also known as Tasnim Jamia Masjid) has been established to promote to further or benefit the residents of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham and neighbouring areas within London, without distinction of sex, sexual orientation, race or of political , religious or other opinions by associating together the said residents and local authorities, voluntary and other organisations in a common effort to advance education and to provide facilities in the interests of social welfare for recreation and leisure time occupation with objective of improving the conditions of life for the residents.

For the promotion of religious practices and the benefit of the public, the centre is engaged in building, maintaining and operating a place of worship through the provision of regular five times daily prayers , Friday (Jummah) prayers as well as sociocultural and religious events.

The charity is organised with a committee (Board of Trustees) elected by the members to oversee the overall activities and one of the committee member is nominated as chairperson, to monitor the day to day running of the charity.

The trustees are eligible, in committee, to appoint additional trustees under the terms of the constitution.

Review of Transactions and Financial Position:

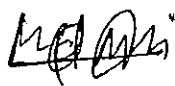

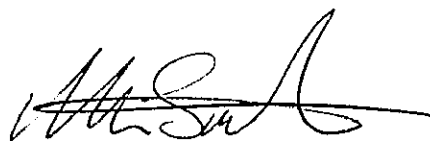

Notes to the financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2022

1.1 Basis of preparation of accounts:

These accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention with items recognised at cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant note(s) to these accounts.

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with:

the Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting and Reporting by Charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) issued on 16 July 2014 and with the Charities Act 2011

1.2 Recognition of Income :

These are included in the Statement of Financial Activities (SoFA) when:

- the charity becomes entitled to the resources;
- it is more likely than not that the trustees will receive the resources; and
- the monetary value can be measured with sufficient reliability.

1.3 Offsetting:

There has been no offsetting of assets and liabilities, or income and expenses, unless required or permitted by the FRS 102 SORP or FRS 102.

1.4 Grants and donations

Grants and donations are only included in the SoFA when the general income recognition criteria are met (5.10 to 5.12 FRS102 SORP).

1.5 Tax reclaims on donations and gifts

Gift Aid receivable is included in income when there is a valid declaration from the donor. Any Gift Aid amount recovered on a donation is considered to be part of that gift and is treated as an addition to the same fund as the initial donation unless the donor or the terms of the appeal have specified otherwise.

2.1 Liability recognition

Liabilities are recognised where it is more likely than not that there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to pay out resources and the amount of the obligation can be measured with reasonable certainty.

2.2 Governance and support costs

Support costs have been allocated between governance costs and other support. Governance costs comprise all costs involving public accountability of the charity and its compliance with regulation and good practice.
