THE RELIEF OF UNEMPLOYMENT FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC IN SUCH WAYS AS MAY BE THOUGHT FIT, INCLUDING ASSISTANCE TO FIND EMPLOYMENT AND TACKLING THE BRUTALITY OF LACK OF REWARDING EMPLOYMENT; 3. 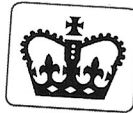
