However, mainly due to issues arising out of the Coronavirus pandemic, this has been delayed until 2021.

The links to a number of organisations relevant to the progress of the project have been followed up during 2020 and efforts to locate a suitable place for display where the tram might ultimately be located once restored are ongoing.

2020 has been another quiet year financially for the Trust other than the purchase of the metalwork referred to above at a cost of £800. The bank balance at 31 December 2020 of £5,8611 is considered adequate for the Trust's present needs but considerable further funds will be required once restoration can begin in earnest.
