Objectives and activities

The objects of the charity are to advance education by providing scholarships, bursaries and awards to, and grants for, young people from disadvantaged backgrounds in pursuance of their studies.

Achievements and performance

The charity continued to accumulate donations and made a gift of £2,914 to pay for the school fees of three students attending Christian Bilangual Institute of Bâtisseur in Benin. The charity also purchased new laptops for each of the students to support them with their learning and studying.

Financial Review

During the period, the charity received £315 in donations, spending £4,355 on charitable activities and £435 on support costs. This resulted in a loss for the year of £4,475.

The members have not required the company to obtain an audit in accordance with section 476 of the Companies Act 2006.


