### **OUR ACTIVITIES :**

Our journey in this field has been very slow and daunting as the effects of the pandemic is still biting. However, we continued our support for the prison fellowship which Pastor Tony is a member. We were able to send 23 parcels to the children of the inmates as Christmas presents from their parents. We also joined the All Souls Ministry in spreading the Good News to various communities and helping the homeless on the streets with small gifts and encouragement.

### **FINANCES :**

As most of our activities are now online, this has seriously affected our finances as membership has dropped, reason why we joined forces with our sister faith group to effect most of our activities though always sponsoring our members in transportation, food and indirect assistance.

### **ORBITUARARY**

We are saddened by the death of our dear sister and former trustee who deputised for our secretary. She passed away with COVID, we are yet to retrieve some of our documents and records, ie. books from her family if possible.

**YOUTH TRAINING** : This was suspended until further notice.

**MERGER:** This topic is still ongoing as to who to merge with if possible, even though we are divided in a merger, members are being given ample time to deeply think about this, with the counsel of the trustees, digging deep into advantages and disadvantages of a merger.

**NO ONE BEYOND HOPE** : We effectively combined this with home visits, targeting families with mental health issues. This really went well as we were able to visit at least 4 families, two of which we revisited more than twice, so we hope to continue and also try to reach out to any volunteering mental health professional to help us deal with specific issues outside our scope.

On the whole it has been quite an eventful year on the background of this pandemic.
