During the period under review, having regard to guidance issued by the Charity Commission on Public Benefit, the Trustees made donations to Medical Action Myanmar (MAM), which is registered as a charitable organisation with the Chamber of Commerce in Amsterdam under number 34345953.

MAM is a medical aid organisation established in 2009, whose mission is to improve access to health care for the poorest people living in Myanmar. MAM supports a network of Community Health Workers to provide health care in some of the most remote villages in Myanmar, and operates static clinics both in rural areas and in the poorest parts of the capital, Yangon.

The money raised by MAM UK in the year has gone towards the activities of Medical Action Myanmar, including supporting those displaced by the conflict in Myanmar.

This included a of £16,800 used to fund the Jenny Walton Masters Women's Health Project for female health education services.
