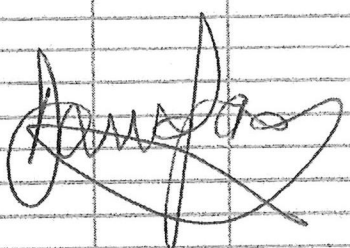

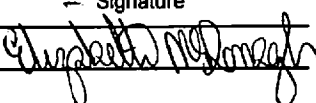

Year End Report 2021

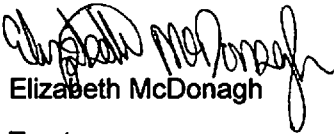
This past year the Sanctuary has again had Covid 19 restrictions curtailing normal activities. When possible various fundraising events have gone ahead with table top sales, online auctions and a successful open day at the Sanctuary.

The Penny Jones Animal Hospice charity shop in Carlisle has gained a new and talented volunteer manager. An internal revamp of the shop has taken place and the shop is now updated with a wonderful rota of volunteers to staff the shop.

Storm Arwen in November hit Cumbria hard and there was damage to buildings at the Sanctuary. All animals were safe but the hay barn and some kennels were badly damaged and need to be replaced. Fundraising was put in place and re-building can now proceed.

During 2021 despite Covid and Brexit issues 117 dogs and 6 cats were welcomed to Penny Jones. Up to date 79 dogs and 3 cats have been successfully re-homed during 2021.

We are now looking forward to live fundraising events with so many dedicated volunteers to drive this forward and looking forward to many more successful rescues being re-homed.
