Our charity's aim is to help the school establish itself sufficiently to be able to make itself independent of our financial help and to this end in 2019 we embarked on a funded programme which had a promising start with responsibility for administrative systems, including accounts and health and safety policy being transferred to the school. By 2020 progress had been made with the database and local fundraising. The school started collecting fees again from those families who could afford to pay and they relied again on support from us and from charities in Italy. Progress has been very limited in raising funds in Colombia and the school becoming financially self-sustaining.

Our income in 2024, as in 2023, relied on our regular sponsors and donors. Following a request for additional funding from the school we sent £12,500 to the school which we advised them had reduced our reserves.

Our charity's costs remain negligible; We have no offices, paid staff or equipment and this year's small charges are again for foreign currency transactions.

Excerpt from Headteacher's report:

Pupil performance

This year, students' academic performance has shown significant progress.

Students have met and exceeded the established goals in key areas such as mathematics, language, science, technology and physical education. Thanks to reinforcement programs and personalized support, we have seen improvements in overall grade point average and increased participation in school activities.

The school restaurant has also had a positive impact on academic performance.

Before, some children arrived without breakfast, which affected their concentration and performance in class. With daily breakfast in the restaurant students are now starting the day with energy, which has been reflected in their attention span and their performance in the classroom. The children's progress has improved a lot, since they have the opportunity to have breakfast in the school which helps their concentration and allows them to learn easily, develop activities with more enthusiasm and creativity.

The future

We have to accept that fundraising in Colombia is a challenge. The school management in Colombia is taken up with teaching the children and do not have time or expertise for matters outside of school. We have concerns that school expenses are exceeding income and needs to be addressed by the school management.

News from Colombia

The school was opened again to the children in February 2021. Time and funds had to be diverted to deliver a new regime of testing, masks and disinfecting surfaces to ensure cases of COVID were prevented. Incredibly, they reported no cases at all.

Being back together was a positive move: Sonia, the head, wrote in her May 2021 report to us:

“Seeing their teachers and classmates and being back in the school building has motivated them much more. We notice that they have taken more responsibility for their learning and valued their lessons as something important in their lives.”

The school recruited a music teacher and the musical instruments they had bought with help from donations from Italy were put to good use and Sonia sent us a video of the children playing at the graduation ceremony in November.

The future

We are conscious that the school's progress towards independence is slow. Roberto Martignago, our contact and support on the ground in Colombia, tells us this is how it is in Colombia and any small steps should be appreciated.

Our charity's aim is to help the school establish itself sufficiently to be able to make itself independent of our financial help and to this end in 2019 we embarked on a funded programme which had a promising start with responsibility for administrative systems, including accounts and health and safety policy being transferred to the school. Progress was made with the database and local fundraising. This continued into the beginning of 2020.

In 2020, as with elsewhere in the world, Colombia had to deal with COVID-19. The school premises closed, and teaching was done remotely. Many of the children's' parents lost work due to the pandemic and many had no internet connection or technology for receiving lessons. The small fees paid by the parents dried up and left a deficit in the budget.

TKSF recruited more sponsors and their donations contributed £5500 to the running of the school this year. £5000 was contributed by Education and General Charitable Trust. Our accounts for the year show £11572 was sent to the school and for funding the project. We have a balance of over £13,547 on deposit at the end of 2020.

Our charity's costs remain negligible; We have no offices, paid staff or equipment and this year's small charges are again for foreign currency transactions.

News from Colombia

When the school had to close during the lockdown and teaching was done remotely, the director of the School, Sonia Diaz, organised smartphones and tablets for the children who had none and lessons were done via WhatsApp. There was considerable inventiveness by the teachers to communicate with the children and they worked long hours to encourage the children in difficult circumstances.

The possibility of raising funds in Colombia diminished as the pandemic took hold. Roberto Martignago, funded to help transfer the responsibility of fund-raising from TKSF to Colombia, did manage to secure funding of 2500 euros from an Italian charity. They have committed to further funding next year (2021).

The future

COVID has caused much uncertainty this year and poorer countries such as Colombia have been affected badly. Our optimism of last year is tempered by caution this year. We may need to accept that the route to independence for Talita Kum School is a little slower than we had predicted and hoped for.
