Funding to start up a small poultry business has been provided utilising land purchased in the previous financial year. It is hoped that the business will provide a degree of self-sufficiency.

Expenditure: During the year £2078 has funded school fees. £500 has been utilised to develop a small poultry business.

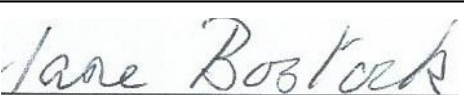

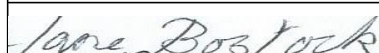
