The process of changing mandates etc has just about been completed.

Due to Covid restrictions there had not been any fundraising opportunities to cover these. Another of £75 was made in May 2021 to a parishioner for a medical procedure plus travelling expenses. Deliberations on both of these applications were made via the internet due to Covid restrictions.

Income for the year was £8.56 - interest on the deposit account.

As of July 2021 there is £40,200.33 on deposit and £1872.21 in the current account. The charity continues to advertise the availability of funds for grant aid.
