In the same month all three Trustees attended a Zoom meeting of the Dorset Group of the Society for the Protection of Ancient Buildings and helped make plans for Group visits and working parties later in the year.

In October, the Trustees held a telephone meeting at which they agreed that the Trust should be wound up at the end of the year and the remaining funds should be donated to the Restore fund for the repair of the roof of Blandford Parish Church, as this was closely similar to the aims and objectives of the Historic Buildings Trust.
