Report of the Trustees for the Year Ended 31 March 2025

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2025. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The objects of the Charity as set out in its governing document are:

1. To work for the assistance of persons who are suicidal, despairing or in distress by providing a service primarily intended for the benefit of persons in Swansea and the surrounding area (but without specific limitations to area) to enable such persons to receive immediate help, compassion and befriending from members of the Charity selected and prepared for the purpose working under direction; and also where appropriate, in accordance with Samaritan procedure, referral to persons having specialist or professional skills.
2. To support the company and aid in the establishment and support of probationary branches and the support of recognised branches of Samaritans.

Public benefit

The Trustees have paid due regard to the Charity Commission guidance on public benefit, and keep it in mind in all developments, to ensure that all our activities are delivering benefit to the public, as defined there.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

During the year the Charity continued to provide emotional support to people by Telephone, SMS, Email or face to face. The Charity operated a listener scheme in Swansea Prison and worked in Partnership with other Organisations to provide emotional support.

Fundraising activities

During the year the Charity continued to fund raise to support the running of the branch and operated a Charity Shop.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

The results for the year and financial position of the Charity are shown in the annexed financial statements.

The net surplus for the year amounted to £748 (2024: Deficit £14,284). A surplus of £964 (2024: Deficit £9,069) is attributed to unrestricted funds and a deficit of £216 (2024:£5,215) is attributed to restricted funds.

At 31 March 2025 the balance on unrestricted funds amounted to £285,456 (2024: £284,492) and the balance on restricted funds amounted to £5,406 (2024:£5,622).

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

The Trustees consider it prudent to carry reserves, in keeping with the Charity Commission Guidelines, amounting between twelve and eighteen months of total running costs. For the current year this would amount to £87,879 (2024:£88,203). Unrestricted reserves as at 31 March 2025 amount to £284,492 (2024:£293,561). This is inclusive of all fixed assets, which the Trustees acknowledge is greater than required under the guidelines but in keeping with the formal reserves policy of the branch. Excluding the property the Charity's reserves currently stand at 18 months (2024: 14 months). The Trustees are committed to ensure that the maximum benefit accrues to the charity and its beneficiaries from the current level of reserves and that income streams are reviewed regularly.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust and constitutes a Charitable Incorporated Organisation.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The methods, policies and procedures for recruitment, appointment, induction and training of new Trustees are in accordance with the Charity's constitution.

Indemnity Insurance

The Samaritans has centrally effected professional indemnity insurance to protect employees, trustees, directors and other volunteer members of all Samaritans Branches.

Risk management

In accordance with the SORP, the Trustees recognise the risks to which the charity may be exposed. The Trustees have carried out a review of such risks in order to identify risks that may be applicable to The Samaritans of Swansea, and to initiate systems in order to mitigate those risks.

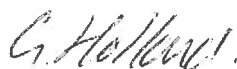

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, with the exception of investments which are included at market value.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Fixtures and fittings	- 25% on cost
Office equipment	- 25% on cost
Shop fixtures & fittings	- 25% on cost

No depreciation is provided for on Freehold Property & Improvements as the Trustees pursue a full repairing policy.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
