Annual statement 2024/2025

Unfortunately this year the charity has made the decision to close. Following a discussion at what would be our final AGM we have come to the decision that since the family bereavement caused myself to take a break as chair of the charity the other trustees have not been active enough to support the running of the charity when I was forced to take a step back for my own wellbeing.

John, the previous chair and co founder has now fully retired and the source of fundraising he had from his connections with a local church is no longer available. This was one of our main single sources of funding at around £1000 each year. Our trustee supporting fundraising and events, Sharon has been approached to run and support a local charity that she would like to invest her time into and has requested to step down as trustee. This leaves just myself to run the charity.

This year our only fundraising event was the Christmas fair that we share with a local rugby club. The rugby club has been very generous in supporting our charity over the years but as our most charities and community volunteer groups they are also beginning to struggle for funds and have had to withdraw sharing the Christmas fair fundraising with us going forward.

After consultation and discussion with our treasurer and accounts it has been agreed that we can no longer function and commit as a group of trustees to run the charity. We have currently got an issue with the GiftAid and are trying to resolve this with the tax code attached to it. It has been agreed that once this has been resolved and the charity has been able to send over the giftaid owed to us to Chaddy Mission School that we support then we will contact the few individual supporters that we do get a donation from and take the steps needed to close down the charity.

It is with a heavy heart that this decision has been made after almost 10 years of building fundraising into a charity and then attempting to continue the charity myself but it is what is best going forward and a decision that has been coming for a while. As chair and co founder I have done my best to independently continue to keep the charity going for as long as I can but unfortunately the time has come where it can no longer continue without the commitment of trustees and without access to regular

fundraising. We have struggled for a while and this past financial year we just have not been able to produce what is needed to ensure the longevity of the charity.

As an individual I will continue to volunteer and support wherever I possibly can to support access to free meals and education within the poverty stricken slums of Nakuru, Kenya as it is a cause that is still very close to my heart.

Trustee Annual Statement 2023-2024

This year has seen a number of changes regarding the charity infrastructure and day to day routine due to both professional and personal circumstances. They have presented many challenges but as always we have done our best to keep the fundraising going to support Chaddy Mission School and so all that we can to ensure that we support the continuation of a free education, feeding programme and community support for all this who benefit from our work.

This year has seen some success with the school continuing to be successful in providing a primary certificate of education free of charge to a growing number of students each year and staff turnover has dramatically reduced thanks to being able to provide funding towards the school's day to day costings. As always we hope that this opportunity of a free education will go on to help the community have a brighter future and progress onwards. The school has largely remained unchanged with not many building projects or maintenance needed this year thankfully as fundraising and resources have been significantly lower for the charity.

Our trustee John climbed Kilimanjaro in aid of the charity, which was an incredible success and our biggest fundraiser for the year alongside a fantastic donation from Reverend Tony Luke who had done his own fundraising following a visit to the school in Kenya. The reverend noted that the children had nowhere to play and took it upon himself to raise money for a playground at the school. Of course as a charity we supported this fantastic idea of which resulted in a slide and some swings for the children at the school.

Unfortunately the charity is now in a position where we are struggling to continue. Since the loss of our previous trustee in charge of fundraising and events we have had no event apart from a Christmas fair. John, our co-founder, has now retired and moved home resulting in him stepping down as chair of the charity and requesting that myself as co-founder step into the role officially as the lead of the charity. However this has been a struggle, with other trustees beginning to step back due to other priorities and myself being a full time carer for a family member alongside working a full time job, the charity is becoming more difficult to prioritise.

All our trustees are voluntary and do what we can with the time we have. Our hearts are all committed to the cause but going forward a serious consideration is needed as to whether the charity can continue. A priority going forward will be to see if we can widen our net of volunteers, reach out to see if there are additional trustees that we could recruit on a

completely voluntary basis to help with fundraising and social media so that we can try to continue. The charity is currently at a transition where difficult decisions need to be made to ensure that we can move forward and continue our work effectively.

I move forward as always looking with the intention to seek solutions to our problems, to continue our mission and with prayers that our charity can continue to do the incredible work that we set out to do.

Annual report 2022-2023

Another challenging year for the charity as we continue to suffer from the difficulties of trying to establish our routines and fundraising events following a break of activities. Last year we decided to focus more on organised events moving forward. However, the venues that usually support us with reduced or free facilities have been impacted with rising costs and are no longer able to do this, significantly impacting our capacity to put on events for a decent profit.

We did have great success again with our Christmas Fair this year with good attendance and have gained a good reputation for hosting the event annually. We looked forward to again providing this event later on in the year and hope to continue to with this. As a team we have discussed in depth the input that goes into our events versus the output and have decided to no longer host our summer fayre events. For the time and effort that goes into them, plus the rise in financial costs for hosting such events it is unfortunately no longer something that we feel is worth investing in. A huge part of this decision also comes from a change within the trustee team.

Just at the end of the latest tax year, we did an official handover meeting from John Savill, our chair to the new nominated chair Jenny Roberts. John and Jenny have always worked alongside each other as chair and vice chair since founding the charity together. John decided that he was at a time in his life where he was ready to step down and it was a unanimous decision amongst the trustees for Jenny to step up from vice chair to chair. Thankfully John remains with us as a trustee and continues to support the charity. Another change to the trustee team came with the departure of Zoe Carter, our social media and events co-ordinator. Zoe has been an incredible asset to the charity with her knowledge, skills and networking gaining the charity events a great reputation with contacts that continue to support our events year after year. For this the charity will be forever grateful. We are sad to see her leave the charity but wish her well with her promotion and new career and she departs her voluntary trustee position in the charity to focus on this.

Thankfully we were able to welcome a new social media and event co-ordinator in Sharon Salt, A long time supporter of Chaddy Mission Kenya who has also spent time volunteering at Chaddy Mission School in Kenya so has a really good understanding of the core values of the charity and a passion to support us. Sharon has already brought us new ideas for events.

With a number of changes within the charity, such difficulties in fundraising from our events this year and the loss of one of our biggest annual donations from January 2023, it has been decided for the charity to regroup and consider a long term strategy. The next few months may be quiet for activity as we reflect on the last 12 months and consider the best fundraising action plan going forward. We have faith that our new team will continue to do great work but to ensure the longevity of the charity we need to consider how to move forward with an action plan of more consistent funding throughout the year.

Annual report 2021-2022

Another challenging year for the charity with the current economic crisis and the world recovering from the impact of COVID-19. Fortunately we were able to bring back a summer event in August and our annual concert to raise essential funds for our charity. These had to be on a much smaller scale and with many limitations but we were at least thankful to be building the charity profile back up and again and resuming our fundraising.

Due to COVID, we had to really look at our fundraising and sources of income to support Chaddy Mission. As a charity we have always relied on our summer and Christmas large events but we have really had to reconsider how best to use our voluntary time and efforts to channel the most effective way to raise essential funds. We have found that from April 2021 to December 2021, our most successful fundraiser that produced the most fundraising with minimal outgoings was actually the Pennine Way Challenge. Thanks to connections at a local secondary school, some staff volunteered to take part in the challenge to raise funds for Chaddy Mission. The event not only raised over £1000 in combined donations from the team members, but it also had a huge impact on the awareness of the charity and social media presence. Moving into 2022, we have decided to research further into organised events that we can ask volunteers to join in aid of Chaddy Mission.

Our music nights returned this year with another successful evening of a sell out crowd. Again all musicians supported our cause and offered their time free of charge for the event. Currently this is only help in October and there was a conflict with Halloween this year resulting in a delay in the sale of tickets compared to previous events. Moving forward, we are going to seek a larger venue to build on the success of this evening and try to grow the event into a much larger fundraiser potentially held twice a year.

Unfortunately we had a big hit to our fundraising again with the COVID restrictions still in place over the summer but as always our team of volunteers were resourceful in seeking out support from local business to donate raffle prizes. In comparison to previous years support from local business has been a struggle. Understandably the smaller local businesses who would usually support our charity have been hit financially by COVID and were unable to provide as much support so our trustees had to work together reaching out over social media to find support for donations. Another challenge was the cancellation of the Kilimanjaro trek in aid of Chaddy Mission. This has been delayed again for a further 12 months so we have had to pause all fundraising and sponsorship for the event until a new date is confirmed.

Despite the challenges, we have yet again come together as a team and been able to raise the funds needed each month to cover the running costs of Chaddy Mission school. If anything these last 12 months have developed us as a team to work resourcefully, effectively and really consider the most cost effective ways of fundraising. Moving forward, I feel as a team we have developed to be stronger and continue to be passionate about our cause. Our social media presence has grown resulting in a raised profile and a new connection with a local rugby club has provided us with a free base to host fundraising events from each year. The



next 12months will probably give us new challenges to face but hopefully none with such barriers that we have had to overcome this year.

Chaddy Mission Kenya – Chair Report for 2020/2021

The year 2020 will be a year that all in Chaddy Mission Kenya (CMK) and all around the world will remember.

Coronavirus causing the world pandemic affect us all and the function of CMK as a charity. Like all small charities we were not able to hold our usual fundraising events due to UK Government Coronavirus restrictions. Normally each summer CMK has several fundraising events – Manor House Gardens Festival, held in Lee, South East London and the Annual CMK Family Funday Day held in Chadderton, Oldham. These being two main events that in previous years have significantly helped our charity income funds.

Whilst our funding income has been low, the effect of Coronavirus significantly affected the school we support, namely, Chaddy Mission School, in Nakuru, Kenya.

The school experienced two severe lockdowns and was closed during these lockdowns. A decision was taken by the trustees with agreement of the school's leaders our good friends Geoffrey Mbugua and Eunice Aim to continue to retain teachers and two staff members on half pay during closure. We feel this was a wise decision as in previous years teaching staff have resigned from the school due to lack of sustained income. The school needs to retain good quality teachers to perform and to continue to achieve excellent KCPE results from pupils (Kenya Certificate of Primary Education). We are most grateful and very pleased for Geoffrey and Eunice and their wonderful staff who with limited resources, but a bounty of encouragement, and love provide these children with positive futures.

This year's adversity proved fruitful to us as a struggling charity, were able to pay our teachers every month, all be it at half-pay, for the complete year. This is the first time as a charity we have been able to pay teachers and staff each month. In previous years we have only been able to part pay when funds have been very low. So whilst many charities have suffered as a result of Covid and limited funding, we have actually achieved well.

We are very grateful for individuals who regularly support us. During the past year one young person decided to virtually ride his bicycle the equivalent of Oldham, Manchester to Kenya about 4,500 miles raising much needed funds. He was supported by others who virtually rode or indeed rode in the open donating their miles to his tally. This was a remarkable achievement and we are most grateful for this young man's own initiative and achievement. Another person held a raffle with donated prizes – this too was amazing and raised just over half the sum needed for paying teachers for one month. We have had some very generous individual donations too this year. And continue awareness of our monthly teacher sponsorship.

The Church of The Good Shepherd, Lee in South East London again included CMK in their annual tithe and have ask me as Chair, and church member to speak about the charity this June.

I personally have set up "Cherished Glass", turning a hobby of stained and leaded glass into a small repair business. A large part of income from the business being donated to the charity. Although early days it seems to be

working as several repairs have been made locally, with a current commission and prospective future work and commissions.

Jenny working in her school has set up a programme that follows the national curriculum it is hoped to use this in other schools bringing awareness of the needs of Chaddy Mission School and needs in the local school are in Mwariki, Nakuru.

Zoe has taken on the task of seeking grants potentially available to CMK. This is a difficult and time consuming task, especially given the completion involved and the lack of grant resources available to charities working in Kenya during the past pandemic year.

The sponsored trek of Kilimanjaro was again postponed due to Covid. We hope to send a team next year. This year we are taking advantage of the Derbyshire Peak District Challenge entering a team – a sponsored walking event over the Peak District in mid-September, and holding the annual Family Funday in Chadderton this July.

We have further supported the school by sending cases of donated school uniform, clothing, shoes, toys, and stationery through Kenya Exports. We hope to continue with this when we have the resources available. I am again most grateful to our trustees who with their immense enthusiasm work raising the charity awareness through social media and individuals. It goes without saying they have their fingers on the pulse and work far more behind the scenes than myself, and I thank each one of them for their tireless work.

I particularly like the way we always have such common agreements among us as trustees and for us all it is a love and pleasure to help the children of Chaddy Mission long may it continue.
