We are very grateful to all who made it happen and this will enable us to move forward with certainty over our premises.</p> <p>We also celebrated the 60th anniversary of the Community Centre with an afternoon tea attended by the Town Mayor and Mayoress as well as many local residents.</p> <p>Our monthly luncheon club continues to be well attended and is our main fundraiser in the year. Knit and Natter sessions also provide social benefits to local residents.</p> <p>Our regular clubs offer a wide range of activities for all ages and cover many interests – these activities are open for all to join in. In addition we have had many bookings from national groups such as NCT, the NHS and the RYA offering training courses and wellbeing courses for those in the area.</p>

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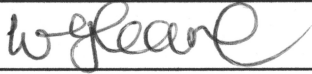
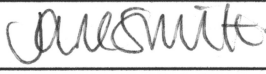
