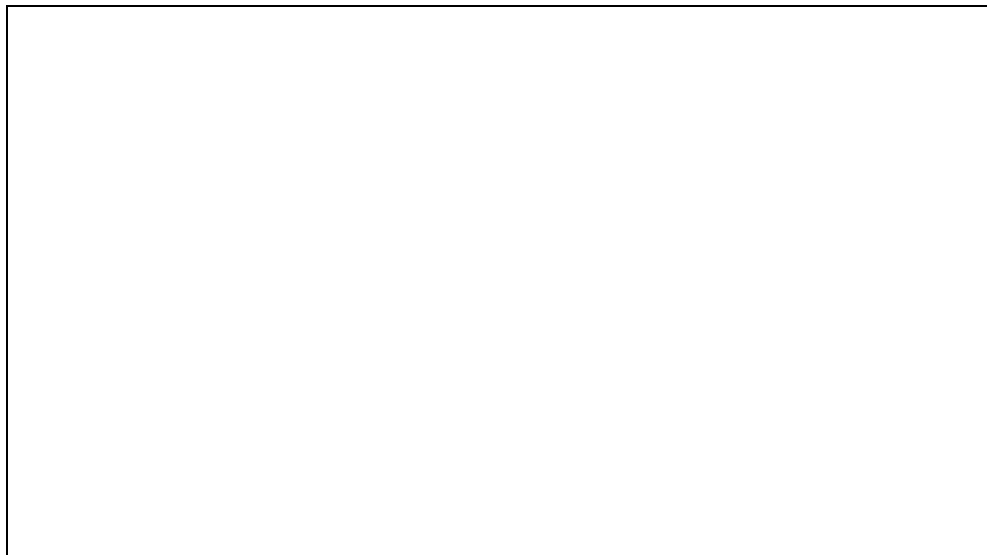



The Sean Edwards Foundation has established SET (The Sean Edwards Test) for safety given to professional and amateur racing drivers prior to competing in order to access their understanding of the rules and regulations of a Championship. SET was introduced in 2015 and has been developed, adopted and mandated by many Championships around the world including British GT, Blancpain, International GT Challenge series, MSVR's LMP3 Cup and GT cup, BRDC F3 and more. SEf is committed to mandating this test and educational programs on a worldwide basis over the coming years. SEF is working on testing for all personal involved in Motorsport.




