Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objectives.

1. Spiritual Practice & Holistic Wellbeing

- **Mind Cultivation:** Conducted fortnightly sessions focused on Buddhist chanting and practice to help participants apply teachings to daily life.
- **Health Support:** Integrated traditional healing by providing free online consultations with a qualified Chinese medical doctor to support the physical wellbeing of our participants.

2. Charitable Resource Distribution

- **Free Materials:** Continued the operation of our distribution centre, providing books, candles, and incense to the public at no cost.
- **Financial Integrity:** Maintained a model funded entirely by public donations with no commercial or business activities, ensuring all resources remain accessible to everyone.

- **Direct Rescue:** Actively engaged in saving animals, with a specific focus on rescuing hens from industrial environments.
- **Sanctuary Support:** Provided ongoing support to animal sanctuaries to ensure a safe environment for all rescued beings.

- **Universal Compassion:** Performed daily spiritual dedications for the benefit of unborn children, those suffering from illness, the deceased, and all sentient beings.



Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objectives.

2. A series of talks delivered by Master Hai Tao on the theme of compassion and love in different cities. These sharing sessions were open to the public to help people deal with the stress they were experiencing in their lives and enable them to lead their lives in a more meaningful and positive way.
3. A Precepts (Jukai) ceremony was held in May. Those who attended received the precepts and formally become Buddhists.
4. Vegetarian feast in Newcastle and London: providing food and drink to local older people who were unwell or experiencing financial difficulties. Distributed food to the homeless.
5. Saving animals. Supporting animal Sanctuary.
6. The Charity distribution centre continued to distribute books, candles and incense to individuals without charge. The Charity entirely relies on donations from the society and there were no business activities during the year.
