The year 2025 has been another very difficult year for SECCA in terms of fulfilling its objectives of supporting the elderly, widows and orphans. This has been due to several reasons:-

1. The need to streamline the delivery of SECCA activities: It was in the interest of SECCA UK Trustees in agreement with SECCA Malawi to focus only on work and charitable activities that are championed through SECCA. Unfortunately, this work has taken time due to the re-organisation of SECCA Malawi resulting in only a few activities being funded. It is the wish of the Trustees that 2026 SECCA will refocus its scope to revert to small, funded projects that will reach out to the masses.
2. Lack of Funding- There has overall been lack of funding/sponsoring from well wishers to fund some of the projects . The only source of income from SECCA is the Monthly contributions by the Trustees. Despite the difficulties with funding, we were also honoured to have received support from the donors below.
 - I. A funding from Charities Aid Foundation (CAF) of £72.66.
 - II. Baby Beat Charity with regular provision of knitted wear that is distributed to vulnerable babies within the communities and Hospitals in Malawi.

It is the wish of the Trustees that 2026 will be approached with a different lens by ensuring that we engage with SECCA Malawi and support small projects that targets the elderly, widows and Orphans within our communities. We all can play our part with the little resources in helping to alleviate the suffering of the orphans, widows and the vulnerable within our society. Doing **NOTHING** is not an **OPTION**.

TRUSTEES REPORT

The year 2024 has been an extremely difficult year for the charity. This has been due to lack of funded activity identified by the team. The aim for 2024 was to change our focus from small projects and sponsoring other small charities to supporting only work that is undertaken by SECCA. However, this transition met with difficulties in identification and coordinating of the projects within Malawi. As result of this compounded with other competing priorities, we were not able to kickstart any projects. The trustees are extremely disappointed by the lack of projects throughout the year, and it is our hope that 2025 will reinvigorate the energy among the team to identify projects that can be funded under the SECCA banner.

Apart from lack of projects, we also suffered lack of financial support from well-wishers. The only income that the charity has managed to source is from the regular monthly contribution from the Trustees. It is the wish of the Trustees that 2025 will attract more funding from well-wishers as we plan to increase the capacity of our projects.

On a good note, I would like to report about the progress of one of the projects that was funded by SECCA in Mulanje on small holder tea farming. Through SECCA small, funded projects 2 years ago, small holder famers were given farm inputs to start tea farming. This has had a good outcome and the small holder farmers have been empowered financially to continue sustaining their farming. See photos below on progress. (Photos taken with consent)

TRUSTEES REPORT

The year 2023 has been very challenging in several ways. Firstly, Malawi faced the worst cyclone in history of the country. Cyclone Freddy resulted in a number of deaths and a lot of families were displaced. To date, some people still remain unaccounted for. The Malawi government declared a state of disaster appealing to donors to support those affected by the cyclone. Following this, SECCA-UK launched a Cyclone Freddy appeal through go Fund and to our well-wishers. SECCA-UK was also in receipt of donations from other charities to support in its appeal to the Cyclone and these deserve a special mention. Baby Beat charity donated material support to the victims and Men4Real donated funds worth £800 and these funds were used to build a house for one of the victims that lost a house in the cyclone. In total our Cyclone Freddy Appeal managed to raise up to £7352.51. These funds were used for the purchase of food packages and transportation logistics of materials in an operation coordinated by our counterparts SECCA MALAWI in conjunction with the Ministry of Disaster and Preparedness. The Trustees would like to thank each donor that responded generously to our cause.



Despite the challenges of Cyclone Freddy, SECCA-UK did not carry much charitable activities as previously planned due to the change in focus of the target projects. We have previously supported small projects within Malawi but going forward it was the wish of the Trustees to see more projects implemented within Malawi under the umbrellaship of SECCA Malawi. Other projects supported in the year were

1. **Tikonze Women group** -£300- This was for a small project in livestock production where beneficiaries were provided with goats with as a source of income, nutrition & assets. It is well known that goat production is environmentally friendly, require less capital,water, land and feed. Hopefully once these goats reproduce they can be recycled to other beneficiaries within the group long term.

TRUSTEES REPORT

SECCA-UK in collaboration with SECCA Malawi and some of its partners, have continued to support the work of the very vulnerable people within Malawi. SECCA Malawi was finally registered after a long process of scrutiny and this will make it easier to support most of its charity work. It has been another year of mixed feelings in regards to the charitable activities undertaken and the lack of funding to support all the projects. There has been a slow pace in the charitable work and I believe this is down to post covid effects.

As Trustees we have continued to prioritise a number of charitable work for the very vulnerable within Malawi with the little resources that we have generated from the monthly contributions by Trustees and from other well-wishers. Notable projects within the year include

1. Financial Support to Mulanje communities (Malawi)-£3000

- a. This support included building a house for now, the late Mr Focus Friday an elderly man from Mulanje. Unfortunately, he died prior to the completion of the house. I believe Mr Friday died a happy man knowing that there were people out there with a good heart that were willing to support and build a permanent dwelling for him that is habitable and does not leak. May his soul continue to rest in peace. There will be discussions with the family to see how best to use the dwelling for community charitable activities.



- b. Funding to support small holder farmers within Mulanje (Tea growing) with the aim of developing self-sustainability in the future.

2. PCM SODIAL DEVELOPMENT FUND- £626

This fund is in support of 12 secondary school learners through the provision of fees for the academic year 2021/22.

3. HOLISTIC CARE £482

Budgetary support for the purchase of food to an orphanage for 3 months.

4. Support of needy students identified in Malawi (£500)

5. Donation of assorted clothes to new born babies, vulnerable adults and children. This has been through the generosity of different individuals including Baby Beat charity in Preston.

TRUSTEES REPORT

The year 2021 has been an extremely difficult year for charitable activities in view of COVID 19 pandemic. This was compounded on a backlog of 1st wave of COVID 19 that brought a halt to a number of activities. Despite these challenges, as a charity we have continued to be involved in a number of activities mainly supporting the COVID 19 prevention. This has had an impact in reaching out to those vulnerable populations who could not afford to buy some of the basic materials for COVID 19 prevention. We also had the opportunity to support COVID 19 lab testing in one of the district hospitals through funding sourced from some of our supporters. This helped in the case management of COVID 19 in a poor resource setting where they had difficulties in procuring COVID 19 testing kits. Apart from the health impact on COVID 19, the economic burden for COVID 19 has made it more unbearable for those vulnerable people within our society. As a result of this SECCA continued its work in supporting the vulnerable and marginalised within Malawi i.e. orphans and widows.

As Trustee's due to the COVID 19 restrictions we were not able to hold any fund raising activities for our Charity. We are however indebted to our Trustees and supporters who continued to donate through their monthly contributions. We were also lucky to have received funds from PayPal Charitable funds. Hopefully with the easing of restrictions and a return to normal activities we will plan for more fundraising activities in the year.

As a charity going forward we will plan to continue to diversify into other charitable areas and also find ways on how we can continue to raise more funds. We would also want to strengthen our working partnership with SECCA Malawi. The recent effects of Cyclone Ana in Malawi will mean that there is need for us to urgently support those vulnerable people within the affected areas. This obviously will be on top of the already existing works that we do to support the vulnerable within Malawi.

Some of the projects funded in 2021 were:-

1. PCM SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT FUND-£491

This fund is in support of 12 secondary school learners through the provision of fees for the academic year 2021/22.

2. HOLISTIC CARE £366

Budgetary support for the purchase of food to an orphanage for 3 months.

3. SUPPORTING THE NEEDY -£451

These funds were in support of multiple requests to support the vulnerable

- Funds were allocated for the elderly within Songani Malawi
- Support to Forum for development of youth
- Visit to a cancer centre

4. COVID LAB TESTING EQUIPMENT-£1,041

Bought testing kits to support COVID 19 case management.
