Regrettably the unexpected & sudden death in late October 2021 of our Chairman and a key Trustee, together with the effects of the pandemic of Covid 19 and the continued absence for a key Trustee for part of the year due to an earlier accident as reported last year still affected a delay in the Charity making the anticipated increase of its profile in the local area and fundraising. This continued to remain a setback to operations and also has resulted in this late filing of the required Annual return

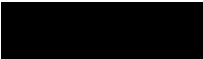
