Aim and purposes

The Chwaen Goch Turbine Fund was established with the sole purpose of distributing money provided by Medium Scale Wind No.1 Limited for the benefit of the local community during the 25 year operational lifetime of the scheme (a single wind turbine located at Chwaen Goch farm, Llanerchymedd, LL71 7BP).

Objectives

The objective of the fund is to provide funding of up to £2,500.00 for any local good cause or project, and priority will be given to projects within a 5 mile radius of the turbine location.

Financial Review

The opening balance on the 1st of May 2024 was £8,888.60. The income received was £2,500.00 annual payment as agreed by Medium Scale Wind No.1 Limited, and this was received on 19/11/24, as well as £5.00 paid in by Mr Carwyn Thomas on 24/1/25 to keep the account active as required by HSBC.

The trustee's decided to have a 'fallow year' for 24/25 due to having numerous consecutive years of heavy funding rounds and the balance of the account having dropped below £9,000. The aim of this being to allow the funds to build up again in order to meet the demand for a funding round in 25/26.

Outgoings amounted to bank charges totalling £60.00

This gave the Turbine Fund a closing balance on the 30 of April 2025 of £11,333.60

Aim and purposes

The Chwaen Goch Turbine Fund was established with the sole purpose of distributing money provided by Medium Scale Wind No.1 Limited for the benefit of the local community during the 25 year operational lifetime of the scheme (a single wind turbine located at Chwaen Goch farm, Llanerchymedd, LL71 7BP).

Objectives

The objective of the fund is to provide funding of up to £2,500.00 for any local good cause or project, and priority will be given to projects within a 5 mile radius of the turbine location.

Financial Review

The opening balance on the 1st of May 2023 was £14,291.00. The income received was £2,500.00 annual payment as agreed by Medium Scale Wind No.1 Limited, and this was received on 17/11/23, as well as £10.00 paid in by Mr Carwyn Thomas on 13/12/23 to keep the account active as required by HSBC.

The fund received four applications during the 2023/24 funding round, with all four applications being successful. Three applications received the full amount sought for their respective projects, with the fourth receiving the maximum grant of £2,500.00. The projects and grants distributed are summarised below:

The trustees did have some reservations about this application due to the grants being intended for specific projects and not ongoing running costs. However the trustees felt that an exception could be made for this project, as noted in this extract of an email to Mr Geraint Thomas who was applying on behalf of the newspaper:

“Whilst we do clearly state that funding should be for specific projects, not ongoing running costs, we feel that the paper provides a vital source of local Welsh language news to large parts of the surrounding communities and as such it is extremely important to keep it going. We appreciate that the cost of everything has increased significantly over recent years and hope that this money will help you to keep the printers rolling towards your 50th year.”

Aim and purposes

The Chwaen Goch Turbine Fund was established with the sole purpose of distributing money provided by Medium Scale Wind No.1 Limited for the benefit of the local community during the operational lifetime of the scheme (a single wind turbine located at Chwaen Goch farm, Llanerchymedd, LL71 7BP).

Objectives

The objective of the fund is to provide funding of up to £2,500.00 for any local good cause or project, and priority will be given to projects within a 5 mile radius of the turbine location.

Financial Review

The opening balance on the 1st of May 2022 was £16,841.40. The income received was £2,500.00 annual payment as agreed by Medium Scale Wind No.1 Limited, and this was received on 18/11/22, as well as £10.00 paid in by Mr Carwyn Thomas on 23/9/22 to keep the account active as required by HSBC.

The fund received three applications during the 2022/23 funding round, with all three applications being successful. Two of the applications receiving the full amount sought for their respective projects, with the third receiving 63%. The projects and grants distributed are summarised below:

Capel Ifan Chapel, Llanerchymedd: New windows for vestry.

The trustees had some reservations over this application. The main concern being that this was the football club's second application in a row for continual ground maintenance, which did not fit completely with the fund's ethos of providing support for specific projects. The trustees felt that the work carried out would not leave a lasting impression. These considerations, combined with the fact that the "pot of money" is going down led to the decision that we offered a grant of £1500 to the football club, which was around 63% of the money sought. This offer was accepted.

The objective of the fund is to provide funding of up to £2,500.00 for any local good cause or project, and priority will be given to projects within a 5 mile radius of the turbine location.

Financial Review

The opening balance on the 1st of May 2021 was £19,488.00. The income received was £2,500.00 annual payment as agreed by Medium Scale Wind No.1 Limited, and this was received on 08/10/21, as well as £10.00 paid in by Mr Carwyn Thomas on 05/08/21 to keep the account active as required by HSBC.

The fund received four applications during the 2021/22 funding round, with three of the four applications being successful and receiving the full amount sought for their respective projects. The fourth application sought £2,808.00, however it is clearly stated that the maximum grant aid is £2,500.00 and this amount was accepted. The projects and grants distributed are summarised below:

Llanerchymedd Community Council: Two benches on the village playing field and dog foul bins. Total project cost: £2,200.00

The trustees had reservations around the £500 sought for 5 years rent as the main purpose of the fund is to provide assistance to specific projects and not pay for fixed costs. After further discussion it was decided that as the rent was a peppercorn rent and support would secure the future of the garden for the community for the foreseeable future, the fund would agree to the full amount sought of £605. The one off nature of this decision was made clear to the applicants.
